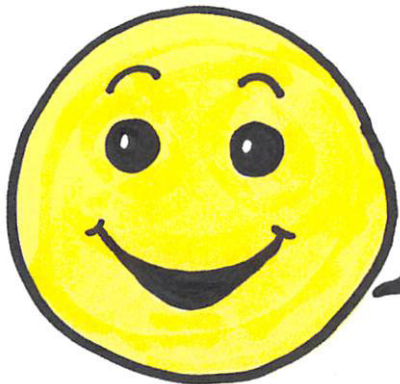

the internet

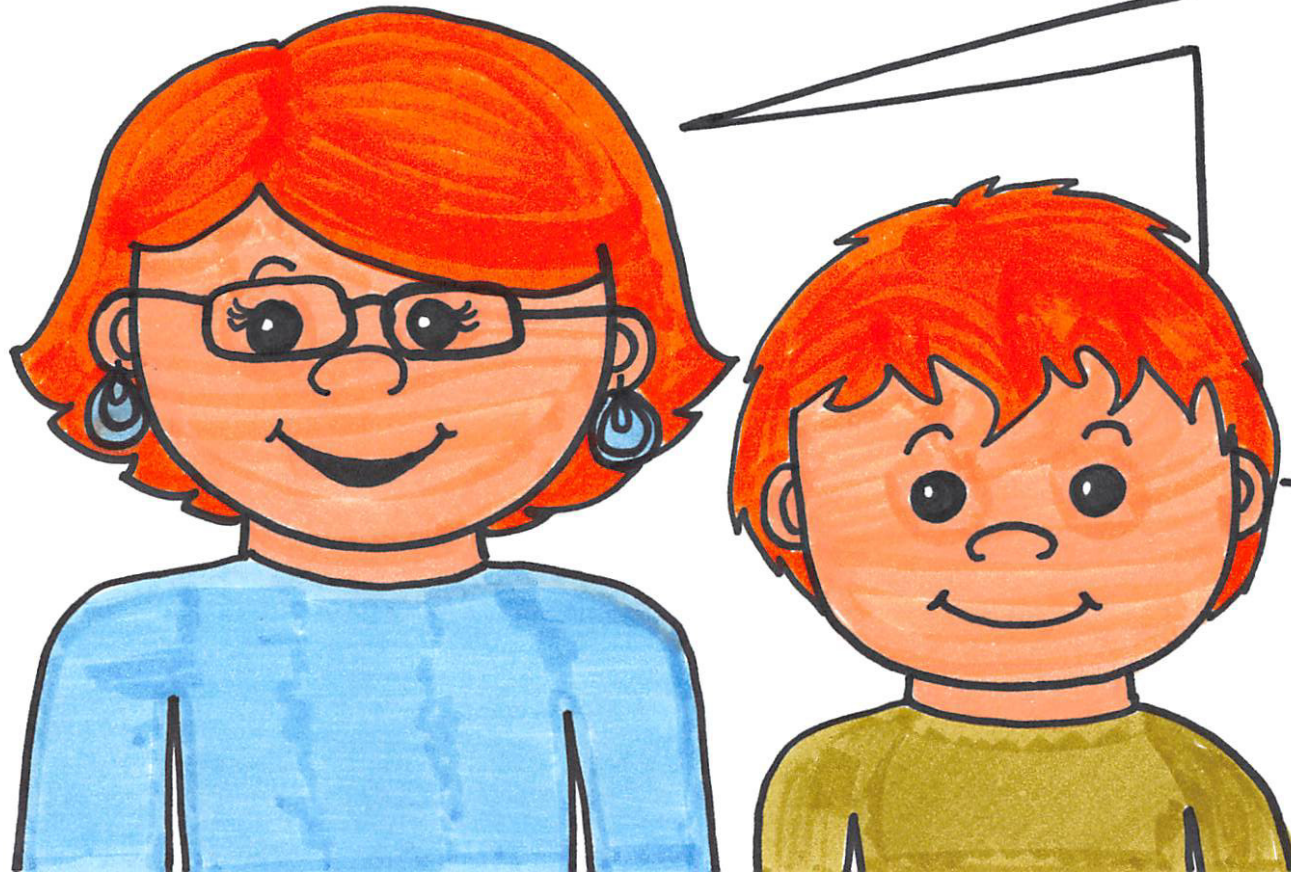
We all do a lot of things each day on the internet - when we are online, it is very important to be

SAFE!!



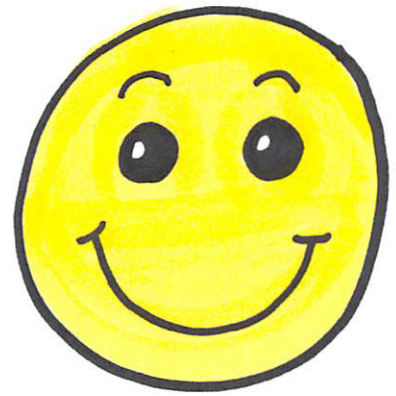
For tips on internet safety,

In order to stay safe online, you need to involve your parents - they can help guide you.



It is your parents' job to keep you safe as best as they can!

If you are doing
research on the
internet, have a
parent either put
filters on what you
can search or sit with
you while you search.



(This makes sure you only see
websites that are okay for kids)

If you use e-mail,
ONLY e-mail people you
KNOW (no strangers)!!

- Teachers

know sends you an email,
do not open it - go get
a parent!!

can then tell
you how to
handle it

If you accidentally end up on a website that makes you feel uncomfortable, get a parent → they can help you and you can talk about it.

Mom! This website makes me uneasy!
Help!



If you are online and
don't know how to find
what you're looking for
ask for help!!

(Don't just go clicking around)



Asking for help will
make you SURE you
will find what you
need without seeing
things you shouldn't!

If you're on a website and accidentally end up on a different website by clicking something, ask for help!

(Don't just keep clicking - you might get really "lost!")



Dad! I clicked a wrong link - can you help me get back to where I was?!

Very important:

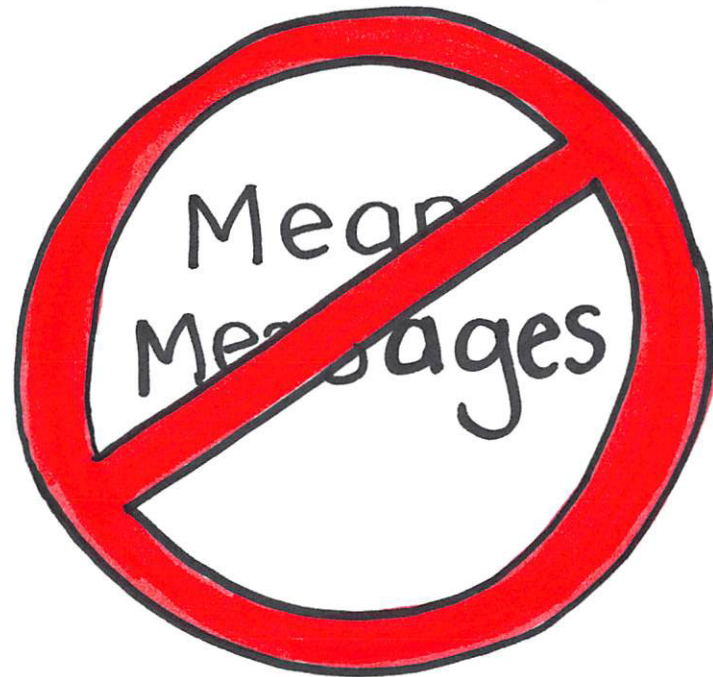
NEVER give out any
personal info. online!!

(personal info. = address, phone number, parent phone number, ect.)



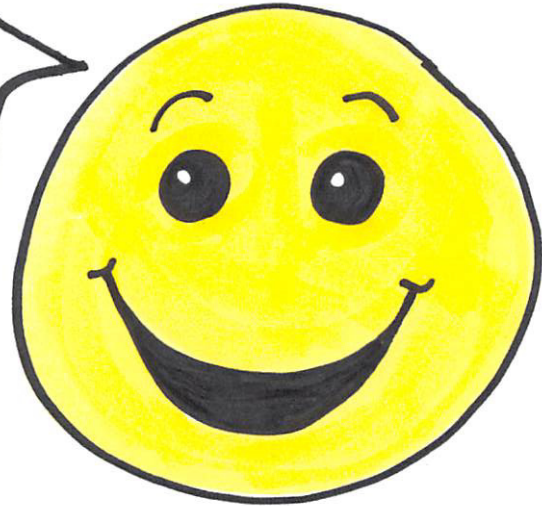
Keep your

If you see or get any unkind messages, do not respond and also tell a parent !!



Before downloading
ANYTHING, ALWAYS
ask a parent first!!

ONLY download
with parent
permission!
