Measure for Shutters

Shutters for windows are measured like this:

- 1. Measure A,B & C and give the narrowest dimension of the 3 to the closest 1/8".
- 2. Measure D,E & F and give the narrowest dimension of the 3 to the closest 1/8".
- 3. Then measure G & H and make sure these are exact or at least within 1/8" of each other. If they are not, contact us and tell us the difference before order.
- 4. Use our "Fractions Chart" to refer to the dimension to use.

Note:

- 1. Windows more than 4' wide should be measured in 4 to 5 places for height as most windows are not perfectly straight or level.
- 2. Always check for "square", G & H, and make sure they are within 1/8" of each other. If they are not, contact us and tell us the difference before order.
- 4. Use our "Fractions Chart" to refer to the dimension to use/supply.
