

GIFT SHOP QUILT PATTERN

Materials and Cutting

Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
 <p>Moonscape Stella-1150 Marshmallow</p>	2 yards	<p>Cut: 5 strips, 2 1/2" x length of fabric (LOF). Sub-cut 5 row sashing strips, 2 1/2" x 56". <i>From remaining yardage, cut:</i> 20 strips, 2" x width of fabric (WOF). Sub-cut 20 block sashing strips, 2" x 14 1/2". 8 strips, 2 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut 64 A squares, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2". 2 strips, 1 3/8" x WOF. Sub-cut 32 C squares, 1 3/8" x 1 3/8".</p>
 <p>Moonscape Stella-1150 Cherry</p>	1 yard	<p>Cut: 7 strips, 2 1/2" x WOF, for binding. <i>From remaining fabric, cut:</i> 4 strips, 2 1/2" x LOF. Sub-cut 4 D rectangles, 2 1/2" x 12 1/2".</p>
 <p>Namasanta Stella-D2469 Navy</p>  <p>Gangsta Wrapper Stella-D2470 Navy</p>  <p>Om Om Om Stella-D2471 Navy</p>  <p>Time to get Blitzened Stella-D2472 Navy</p>	7/8 yard, <i>each</i>	<p>From <i>each</i> fabric, cut: 2 strips, 12 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut 4 B squares, 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".</p>
 <p>Moonscape Stella-1150 Chartreuse</p>  <p>Moonscape Stella-1150 Flame</p>  <p>Moonscape Stella-1150 Kiwi</p>	3/8 yard, <i>each</i>	<p>From <i>each</i> fabric, cut: 4 strips, 2 1/2" x LOF. Sub-cut 4 D rectangles, 2 1/2" x 12 1/2".</p>
 <p>Namasanta Stella-D2469 Navy</p>	3 5/8 yards	Remove selvages and cut yardage into two equal lengths for backing.

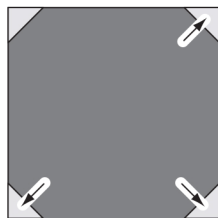
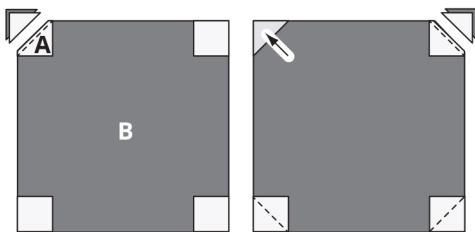


GIFT SHOP QUILT PATTERN

Note: All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise specified. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.

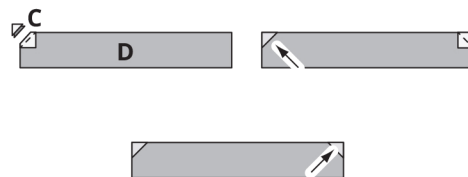
Make the Snow Globe Blocks

1 Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each **A** square. Noting the orientation of the marked line, place one marked square right sides together on a corner of a **B** square, aligning outer edges. Sew along the marked line. Trim the excess corner fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press the triangle open. Repeat to add a triangle to the remaining corners of the **B** square. Make 16 units.



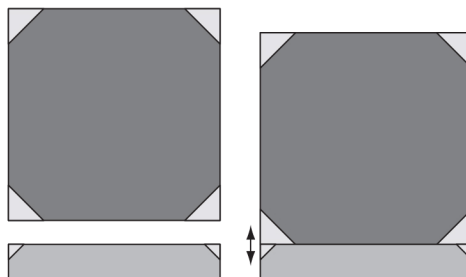

2 Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each **C** square. Noting the orientation of the marked line, place one marked square right sides together on one upper corner of a **D** rectangle, aligning outer edges. Sew along the marked line. Trim the excess corner fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press the triangle open. Repeat to add a second triangle to the opposite upper corner of the rectangle. Make 16 units.

3 Referring to the quilt image for fabric combinations, sew one step 1 unit to the upper edge of a step 2 unit. Press. Make a total of 16 Snow Globe blocks.

Assemble the Quilt

1 Referring to the quilt image for fabric placement and block orientation, arrange the blocks in four rows of four blocks each. Place a block sashing strip between each block and at the start and end of each row. Join the blocks and sashing strips in each row together and sashing strips in each row together along adjacent edges. Press the seam allowances toward the sashing strips.

2 Place a row sashing strip between each block row. Sew the rows and sashing strips together along adjacent edges. Sew one row sashing strip to the top edge and another to the bottom edge of the quilt top. Press the seam allowances toward the row sashing strips.

Finishing

1 Using a 1/2" seam allowance, join the two large backing rectangles along one long edge to complete the quilt backing. Press.

2 Layer the quilt backing, batting, and quilt top. Quilt as desired. Stitch a scant 1/4" from the edge around the perimeter of the quilt. Trim the excess backing and batting. Use your favorite method to bind the quilt.
