## OTHER TOOLS \& SUPPLIES

- sewing machine \& coordinating thread
- rotary cutter \& fabric shears
- straight edge ruler \& measuring tape
- fabric marker or pencil
- straight pins


## NOTES

- WOF = width of fabric
- Unless otherwise directed, sew all seams with a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
- Please wash, dry \& iron your fabric before beginning, and trim selvages.
-Since several of the fabrics have a directional print, some of the pieces will have to be cut lengthwise and some widthwise. We've provided diagrams to help guide you.


## CUTTING

Fabric A
Cut (1) 37-1/2" $\times$ WOF rectangle
Sub-cut (1) 18" $\times 37-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle
(1) $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 37-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle
(3) $9^{\prime \prime} \times 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

Cut (2) 4-1/2" x WOF rectangles
Sub-cut each rectangle to a $33-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.


Fabric B
Cut (1) 5" x WOF strip
Sub-cut (1) 5" $\times 5$ " square
(3) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

From remaining strip:
Cut (1) 2" strip. Sub-cut (3) 9" $\times 2$ 2" rectangles
Cut (1) 3" strip. Sub-cut (3) 9" $\times$ 3" rectangles


Cut (1) 3-1/2" $\times$ WOF strip
Sub-cut (3) 5 " $\times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
Cut (5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Join strips end-to-end and reserve for binding.

Fabric C
Cut (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 5" $\times 5$ " squares

Sub-cut ONE of the squares to $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " rectangles.

Cut (1) 9" xWOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2-1/2" $\times 9^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.

## Fabric D



Cut (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 5" $\times 5$ " squares.

## Fabric E

Cut (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 5" $\times 5$ " square.

## PIECING

1. Assemble Block 1 as follows:
a. Stitch (1) 5 " $\times 3-1 / 2$ " Fabric B rectangle to the top of the 5" x 5" Fabric C square
b. Stitch (1) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B to the bottom of the piece created in Step a.
c. Stitch (1) 2" $\times 9^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B rectangle to right side of the piece created in Step b.
d. Stitch (1) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B rectangle to left side of the
 piece created in Step c.
2. Assemble Blocks 2 \& 4 as follows:
a. Stitch (1) 5 "' $\times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B rectangle to the top of the 5" $\times 5$ " Fabric D square
b. Stitch (1) $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $B$ to the bottom of the piece created in Step a.
c. Stitch (1) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B rectangle to left side of the piece created in Step b.

d. Stitch (1) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B rectangle to right side of the piece created in Step c.
3. Assemble Block 3 as follows:
a. Stitch (1) 5 " $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $C$ rectangle to the top of the $5 " \times 5$ " Fabric F square
b. Stitch (1) 5 " $\times 2-1 / 2$ " Fabric $C$ rectangle to the bottom of the 5 " $\times 5$ " Fabric F square
c. Stitch (1) $2-1 / 2$ " $\times 9$ " Fabric $C$ rectangle to left side of the piece created in Step b.
d. Stitch (1) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C rectangle to right side of
 the piece created in Step c.
4. Stitch all 4 blocks together top to bottom while inserting one 9 " $\times 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle in between each block.

5. Stitch the $18^{\prime \prime} \times 37-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle to the left side of the column created in Step 5 .
6. Stitch the $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 37-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle to the right side of the column created in Step 5.

7. Stitch one $33-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle to the top of the piece created in Step 7 and one to the bottom.


This completes the quilt top.

FINISHING THE QUILT
8. Layer your quilt top, batting \& backing. Baste \& quilt as desired, trim the excess batting \& backing, and bind with Fabric B binding strip.
