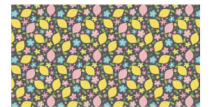

(1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (40) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>b. Sashing rectangles (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (5) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles. (1) 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (26) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>c. Inner border (5) 3" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3" x 40 1/2" and (2) 3" x 44 1/2" strips.</p>

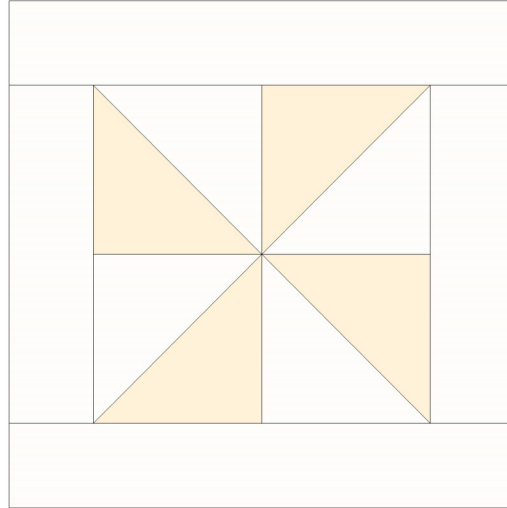

Constructing pieced blocks

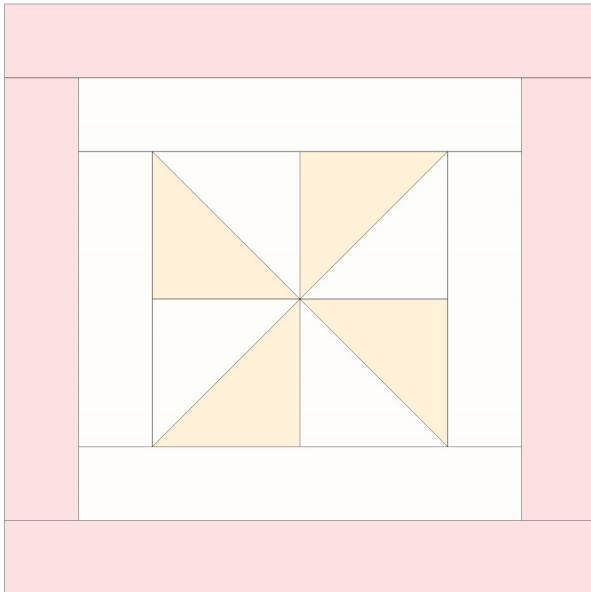
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3" x 3" Background square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 3" x 3" Fabric 1 square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press. Align diagonal seams of HST unit against 45 degree line on quilting ruler. Trim units to measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make a total of (4) units, and sew to make a pinwheel unit.



2. Sew (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Background rectangles to the opposite sides of step 1 unit, followed by (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Background rectangles to the remaining opposite sides of step 1 unit.












3. Sew (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 2 to the opposite sides of step 2 unit, followed by (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 2 to the remaining opposite sides of step 2 unit to complete (1) pieced block. Block measures $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.









Quilt Top Assembly

1. Pieced rows. Refer to quilt image for block placement guide, arrange and sew together (4) pieced blocks and (3) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$ Background rectangles to make a pieced row. Make a total of (5) rows. Row 1 is shown below.



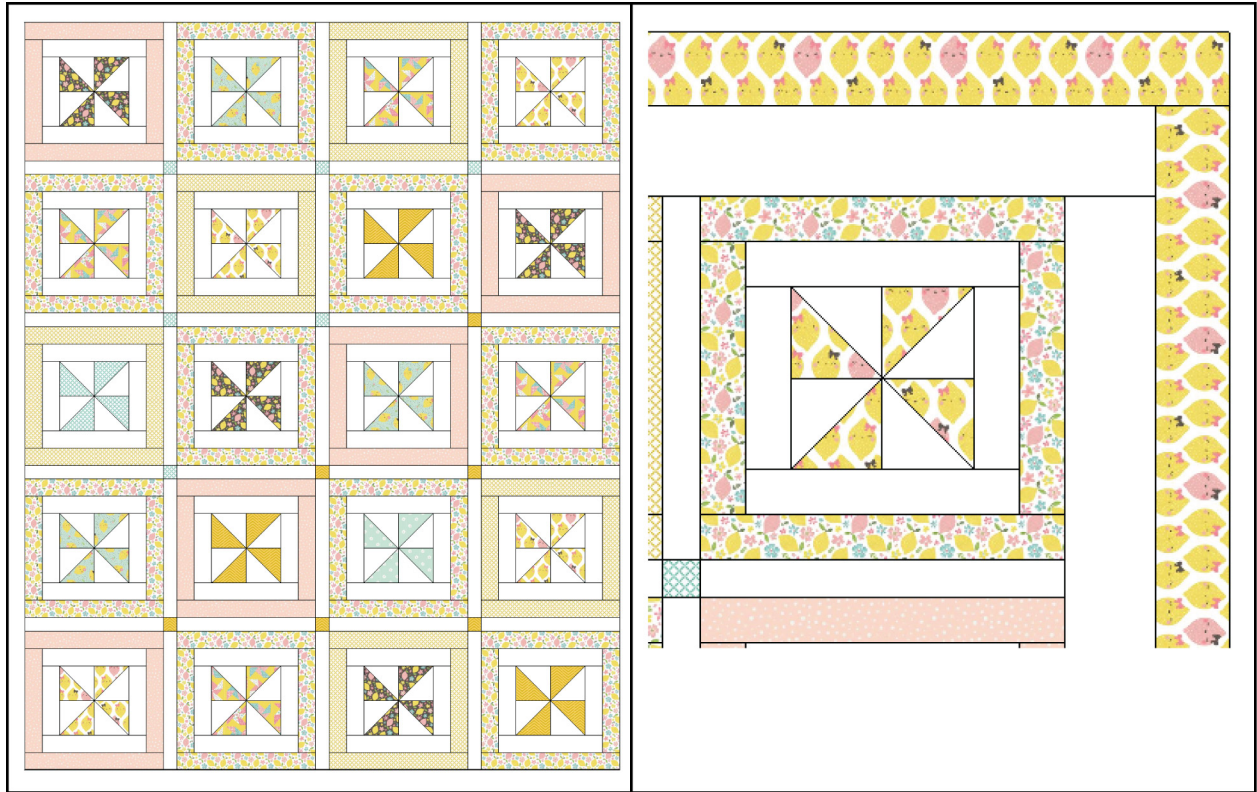
2. Pieced sashing rows. Arrange and sew together (4) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$ Background and (3) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$ squares to make a pieced sashing row. Refer to quilt image for the number of Fabric B or Fabric C $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 1\frac{1}{2}''$ squares used. Pieced sashing row 1 is shown below.



3. Sew together piece rows and pieced sashing rows, alternating.

4. Inner border. Sew (2) $3'' \times 44\frac{1}{2}''$ Background strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $3'' \times 40\frac{1}{2}''$ Background strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.

5. Outer border. Sew (2) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 49\frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric E Strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 44\frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric E strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



Finishing

1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to complete the quilt.
