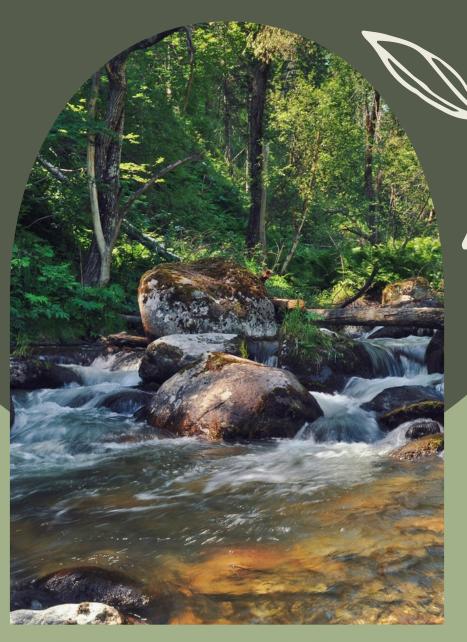
CHOOSE FORGIVENESS

COLOSSIANS 3:13 (NIV)

OVER YOUR HEALING

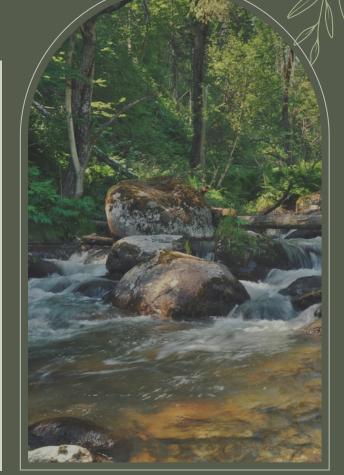
I declare that I choose forgiveness over bitterness.

5 PRACTICAL WAYS TO PARTNER WITH THIS PIECE AS YOU WEAR IT

Speak it aloud - "I forgive ____ for ___." Let your words lead your heart.

Write a release letter - Get the pain out of your mind and body—then give it to God.

Bless the one who hurt you - Prayer breaks bitterness every time.

Forgive yourself too - Don't exclude yourself from grace.

Wear it with purpose - Let Choose Forgiveness remind you: you're walking in freedom now.
