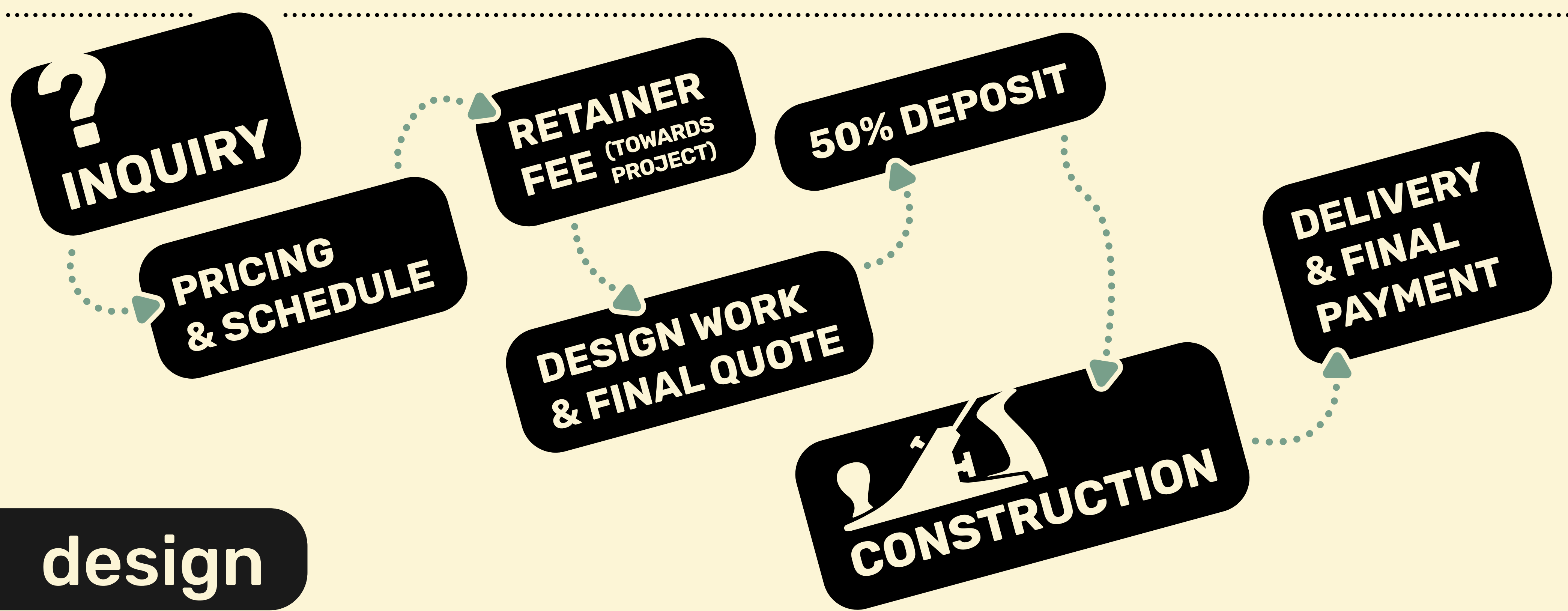

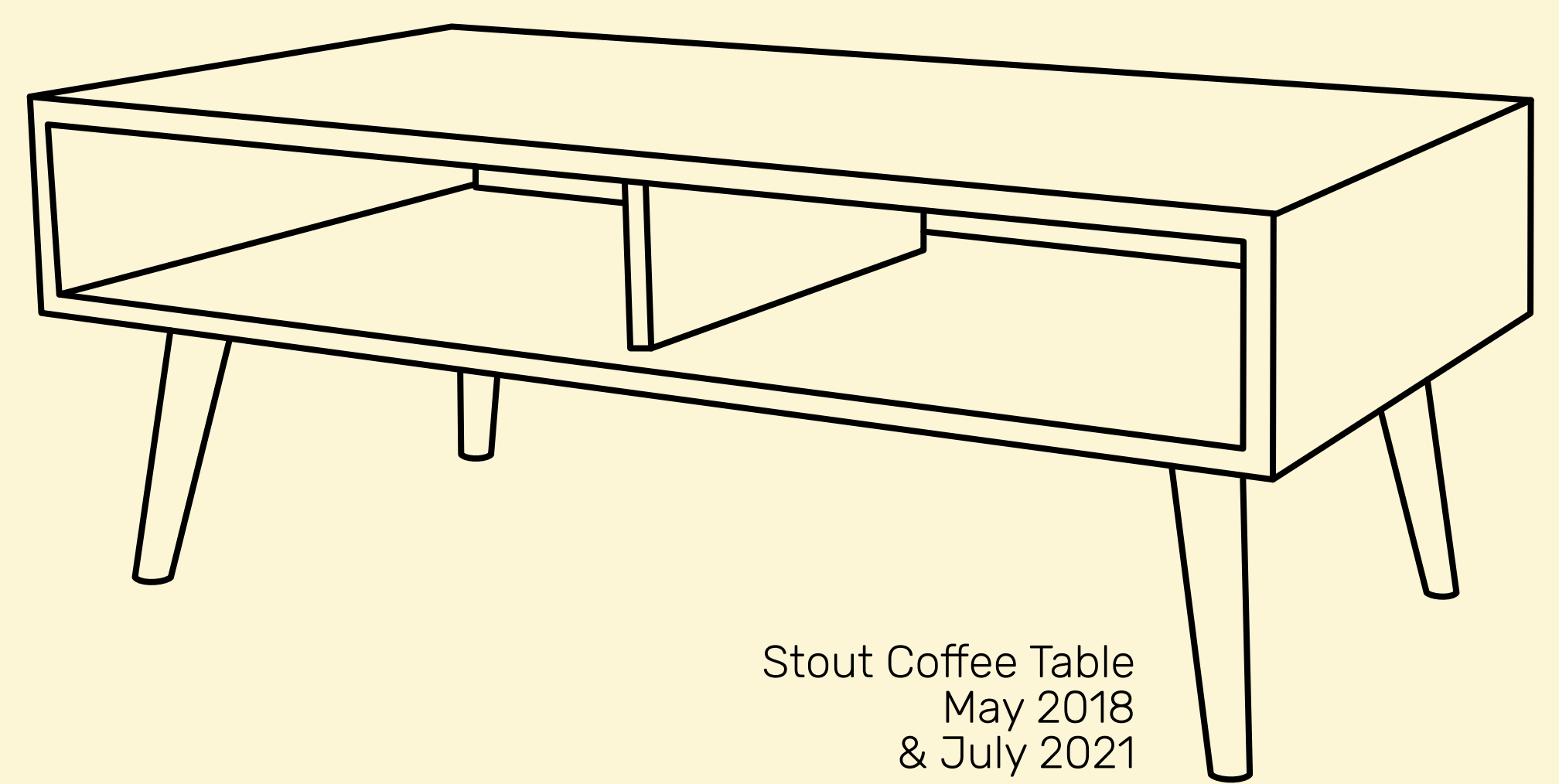

design

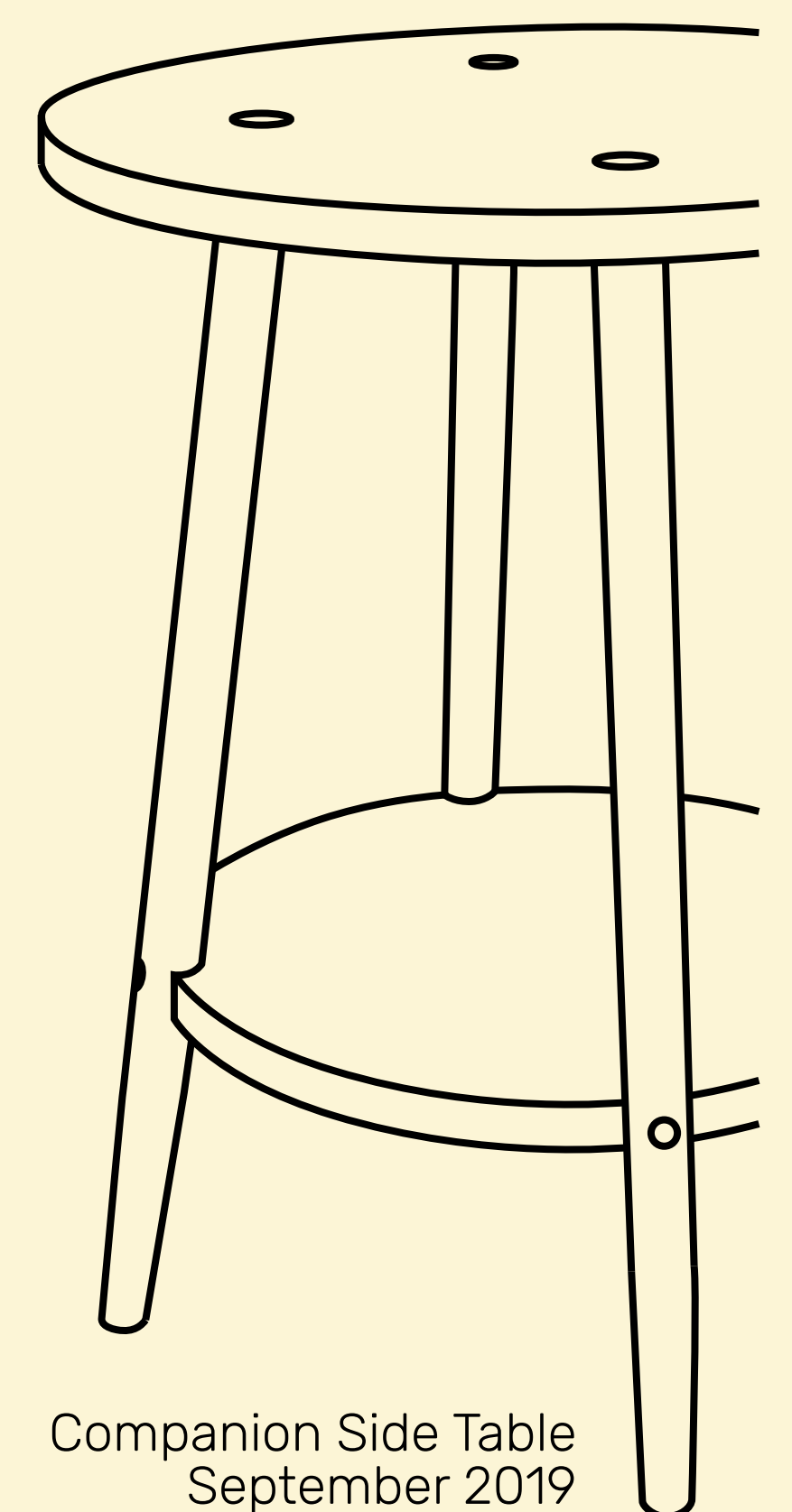
The enduring value of a custom piece depends on high quality raw materials. There are many hardwoods locally available that are sustainably sourced, affordable, highly durable, and will respond well to fine fine woodworking techniques.

construction

We prefer to avoid hardware fasteners whenever possible. Interlocking joinery techniques that maximize glued surface area all-but guarantee heirloom quality durability.

Understanding how different wood species move over time and through the seasons is critical to the joinery selection and implementation.

There is a vast variety of construction methods to consider for any given piece, which we may decide on together to suit the functionality and aesthetic of your piece.

finish

We finish using a natural wax and oil compound that penetrates and conditions the grain while providing a protective outer layer. This finish results in a durable surface that is smooth and rich to the touch, while being kind to the environment.

Coasters are recommended and spills should be dealt with sooner rather than later. Maintenance measures can be taken every other year but are not always necessary.

A complete care guide will be provided with your finished piece.
