#### Safety Precautions

- Read these Safety Precautions carefully before using the device in order to use it correctly.
- Use the device sensibly in accordance with the prescribed steps.
- Immediately discontinue use and arrange to have the device repaired if any abnormality occurs.
- Do not use the device in a defective state, as doing so could cause a physical harm to the user.
- The precautions listed in the User's Manual are very important. For your safety, please follow them carefully.

When carrying the device around or storing it, always attach the head cover.



The design and specifications of the device and attached accessories are subject to change for improvement purposes without notice.

#### **Functions**

#### Lock Function

This feature prevents the device from accidentally turning on when carried around. If you press and hold down the Mode or the Power button for 4 seconds, the button will be locked after 6 short beeps. If you press and hold down the Mode or the Power button again for 4 seconds, the button will be unlocked after 4 short beeps.

#### Auto Power-off

About 3 minutes (in RF Shaver/Shaver Mode) or 6 minutes (in RF Mode) after turning on the power, the power will be turned off automatically after 2 short beeps.

#### Waterproof


This product (excluding the AC adapter) is IPX7 level waterproof\* (JIS waterproof protection class).

- \*The product is not designed to use underwater, so please be careful when using the device in bathrooms or around water.
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$  Never charge the battery when the device is wet.
- $\cdot$  The AC adapter is not waterproof.

#### Before Use

ATTENTION

Before carrying out a treatment, be sure to check the following.



Charging	Charging mark (page 9) flashes in blue
When Charging is Complete	Charging mark (page 9) is lit in solid blue for 10 seconds and then goes out.
Charging Time	Approx. 3 hours (room temperature approx. 15°C ~ 35°C)
Operating Time	Approx. 25 minutes

<sup>\*</sup> If charging does not begin after approx. 10 seconds, check if the AC adapter connection is loose.

 Make sure there is no water on the charging terminal before connecting the device. Failure to comply may cause an electric shock, short circuit, fire, or a malfunction of the device.

#### Never charge the device in the bathroom.

<sup>\*</sup>The device cannot be used while charging. Unplug the AC adapter before use. If you try to charge the device while it is turned on, the power will automatically turn off.

<sup>\*</sup> Design and specifications of the main unit and accessories are subject to change for improvements without prior notice.

#### Pre-testing on Skin

\* When using the device or a cosmetic product for the first time, always test for its compatibility with your skin.

- Clean your skin
  - · Wash the inner side of your arm with a mild soap and wipe dry with a towel.
  - Remove all metal accessories (watches, necklaces, rings, earrings, etc.) when using the device.
     Failure to comply may cause accidents or injuries.
- 2 Apply lotion or water to an inner arm
- Turn on the power and set the device to RF Mode (page 15)
- 4 Use on a test spot, moving the head (page 9) for about 3 minutes

You can use the device if no abnormalities appear on your skin 24 hours after performing the test.



**ATTENTION** 

 If a rash, reddening, itchiness, stinging sensation or other abnormality occurs at the pre-testing area, immediately stop the pre-test.

#### How to Use

#### Modes

This product allows you to treat your skin via the following modes.

Mode	Functions	Mode button (page 9) display
RF Shaver	For shaving while your beard is being directly warmed by RF.  * This is the recommended mode for shaving.	RF SHAVER
Shaver	For shaving.	SHAVER
RF	For treating your skin with RF (Radio Frequency).	RF

### How to shave proficiently (RF Shaver Mode/Shaver Mode)

Lightly apply the blade to your skin and move the device in a circular motion.

(Example) Cheeks: stretch your skin so that the facial hairs stand up, then shave while moving the device in small circles.



st If you are a first-time user, it may take 2 to 3 weeks to get used to shave appropriately.

<sup>\*</sup> If you use the device over makeup, the foundation may cause dark staining of the skin.

#### Basic method of use

RF Shaver Mode (recommended)

- 1 Apply shaving foam or shaving gel evenly to your face
- 2 Turn on the device

Press and hold down the power button (page 9).

RF Shaver Mode will be selected automatically.

3 Shave (page 13)

When finished, press and hold down the power button to turn off the power.

- 4 Rinse your face
- 5 Clean the head (page 17)

Be sure to remove makeup before using the device.

**ATTENTION** 

 Always ensure there is an adequate amount of shaving foam or shaving gel between the electrodes and your skin, and replenish it as needed while shaving.

If there is not enough shaving foam or shaving gel, warmth may be reduced.

#### Shaver Mode

Set to Shaver Mode (page 13)

Turn on the power (page 14) and press the mode button (page 9) once.

- 2 Shave (page 13)
- Clean the head (page 17)

RF Mode

- Wash your face and apply lotion or similar products to your face
- 2 Set to RF Mode (page 13)

Turn on the power (page 14) and press the mode button (page 9) twice.

3 Apply the electrode head to your skin and move the head over the area being treated.

Press the electrode head repeatedly on your face as if stamping on the skin (Press  $\rightarrow$  Release  $\rightarrow$  Move electrode head).

• Estimated usage time: about 3 minutes for half-face treatment (about 6 minutes per session)



4 Clean the head (page 17)

#### Using the trimmer

The trimmer can be attached to the main unit to treat sideburns or shave the area under the chin.


\* Beard length cannot be adjusted.

### Detach the head from the device

Pull the head straight out without turning it sideways.

The head is firmly attached, so you will need to pull hard.

\* Make sure to switch the main power off when performing this action.




### 3 Set to Shaver Mode (page 13)

Turn on the power (page 14) and press the mode button (page 9) once.

\* The trimmer does not emit RF.



Attach the trimmer to the main unit by aligning the latter with the hole on the trimmer, then push it in until it clicks firmly in the place.



4 Lightly apply the top of the trimmer to your skin and move it slowly against the grain of your beard.

\* Do not apply the blade perpendicular to your skin.

#### **ATTENTION**

- Do not use the trimmer on your hair on the head.
- Do not touch the blade.

- Do not use on areas that you cannot examine visually.
- Use up to 2 times on the same area.

#### After Treatment

How To Clean (washing with water): every time

Be sure to rinse the device with water after each use. Be sure to wipe off any water after use.

- Turn on the power with the head/trimmer attached and rinse with running water.
- Turn off the power, press the Open button to open the head and rinse off any hair that may have
  - accumulated.

Open button

- Drain excess water and let it air dry
  - \* Remove the head/trimmer from the main unit and dry with the head open.

Do not wipe the device with solvents such as alcohol, thinner, benzene, nail polish remover, kerosene, chemicals, or polishing powder.



**ATTENTION** 

After cleaning, drain any residual water and make sure there is no water on the main unit. Failure to comply may cause a malfunction of the device.

After use, make sure that any shaving foam and shaving gel have been thoroughly removed. Insufficient cleaning may cause bad odors or malfunctioning.

#### How To Clean (cleaning with the brush, disassembling the head + washing with water): once a week


Use the cleaning brush once the head is dry.

Open the head (page 17) and remove any hair.


Clean with the cleaning brush. Close the head when finished.

2 Remove the blade

Fit the <u>latches</u> of the cleaning brush onto the two <u>dents</u> on the ring of the outer blade and remove it by turning counterclockwise to the <u>"I" mark</u> on the head.




Remove inner blade and ring from the outer blade, wash with running water and dry.



4 Attach the blade

With the <u>dent</u> of the ring facing up, align the <u>latches</u> of the ring with the holes in the outer blade and attach the inner blade. Align the <u>indentation</u> of the ring with the <u>"I" mark</u> on the head and push in. Fit the <u>latches</u> of the cleaning brush on the two <u>dents</u> on the ring of the outer blade and attach it by turning clockwise to the "II" mark on the head.



#### Replacing the blade

The double rotary blade is a consumable item. In order to ensure excellent shaving performance over time, we recommend replacing the blade every two years.

For information on how to disassemble and replace the replacement blade (SA539), see 'How To Clean' (page 18).

#### Storage

- Always remove excess water and dry thoroughly before storing. Leaving the device wet may cause corrosion of the charging terminal or the inside of the
  main unit
- If you will not be using it for an extended period, clean the device before storing it.
- When the device is not in use, turn off the power of the main unit.
- Avoid using or storing the device near a heater or in a bathroom, other high-temperature/high-humidity locations, places where there is exposure to
  direct sunlight, or in unstable locations.
- Keep the device out of the reach of children.
- Do not store in bathrooms or other wet areas.

#### Maintenance and Inspections

- If you have not used the device for an extended period, inspect it carefully and check that it works properly and safely before using it again.
- If the device is malfunctioning, go to 'Troubleshooting' (page 21) and attempt to identify the problem before arranging to have the device repaired.

  If the problem persists, make an inquiry with the Global After Service (https://www.ya-man.co.jp/en/support/repair/) or your local distributor.
- If the device malfunctions, appears damaged, or needs service, please contact your local distributor.

### Error display notification

When an error occurs, the following error information will be displayed.

Check the error details and resolve the cause of the error accordingly.

Error indication	Solutions
The "RF" mode button displays blinks and the charging mark flashes red	The cause is a short circuit between the electrodes on the head. Power is turned off automatically. Turn on the power again.
The "SHAVER" mode button displays blinks and the short buzzer beeps 4 times	The cause is the clogging of the head. Power is turned off automatically.  Open the head and clean it. Turn on the power again. If the power does not turn on, consult the Global After Service (https://www.ya-man.co.jp/en/support/repair/) or your local distributor.

#### Frequently Asked Questions

What are the recommended frequency and length of use?

As a general rule: RF Shaver Mode: 7 days a week (once a day, up to 3 minutes)

Shaver Mode: 7 days a week (up to 3 minutes per session)

RF Mode: 5 days a week (once a day, up to 6 minutes)

Trimmer: 1 day a week (up to 6 minutes per session)

- \* If you use RF Shaver Mode or Shaver Mode for 3 minutes or longer, reduce the frequency of use.
- \* Excessive usage may cause skin damage.

Q Is the device more effective if I press firmly?

A

Do not press the roller firmly. Apply the double rotation blade in such a way that it touches to the skin closely. Apply it lightly so as not to damage your skin.

Can I use the device in the bathroom?

The main unit can be used in the bathroom but cannot be used underwater.

Also, it cannot be charged in the bathroom.

What does it mean when cut hair remains on the skin?

Cut hair waste may remain on the skin depending on the beard's thickness or on the amount/viscosity of the gel. In such cases, wipe it off with tissue. Wash the head with water every time you use it. Also, after using the device, wipe off any remaining moisture thoroughly.

What skin-care products do you recommend?

RF Shaver Mode, Shaver Mode: shaving foam, shaving gel, etc.

RF Mode: lotion (thick lotions are recommended), etc.

### Rechargeable Battery


