Subject: - Correction in the particulars of the online Application Form of Common University Entrance Test [CUET (UG)] – 2023 – Reg.

National Testing Agency is going to conduct Common University Entrance Test [CUET (UG)] - 2023 from **21 May 2023 onwards** at **various examination** Centres located in **different cities** across India and abroad in **Computer Based Test (CBT) mode**. Registration for the aforesaid examination is over now.

As per the information published in Information Bulletin and Public Notice, it has been decided to provide an opportunity to make corrections in the particulars of their respective Application Forms of CUET (UG) – 2023 as per the following details:

Examination	Duration for Correction in Particulars	Field for Corrections
Common University Entrance Test [CUET (UG)] – 2023	01 April to 03 April 2023 (Up to 11:50 P.M.)	As per Annexure 1

Please note that final correction shall be applicable only after payment of an additional fee if required. In case of change in Category, or PwBD, if there is an impact on the fee amount then the Candidate will be charged an excess fee as applicable. Excess payment made will not be refunded, if any.

All the registered candidates for the said Examination are advised to visit the website (<https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/>) and verify their particulars. They are further advised to make correction/s in their particulars, in their respective Application Form, if required.

The candidates are allowed to make the corrections, latest by **03 April 2023 (up to 11:50 P.M.)**. Thereafter, no correction in particulars, whatsoever, will be entertained by NTA under any circumstances. The additional fee (wherever applicable) shall be paid by the candidate concerned either through **Credit/Debit Card/Net Banking/UPI**.

The candidates can also visit their nearest Help Centre (Annexure 2) for making correction (if required) in their respective online Application Forms of CUET (UG) – 2023.

Since, it is a one-time facility extended to the candidates to avoid any hardship to them, the candidates are advised to do the correction very carefully, as no further opportunity for correction will be given to the candidates. The candidates should also regularly visit NTA website www.nta.ac.in and <https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/> for the latest updates.
