
Period blood colour



BRIGHT RED to DARK BROWN RED / BROWN

- Healthy Period
- Spotting due to egg implantation
- Ovarian Cysts

Depending on how new the blood shed from your uterus is, the shade may vary.



PINK to LIGHT PINK / WHITE

- Low flow of fresh Menstrual blood
- Signs of low estrogen levels
- Signs of cervical cancer if pink vaginal discharge sheds outside of your cycle

You'll most likely see pink to light pink blood at the beginning or end of your cycle.



GREY to BLACK

- Old period blood
- Grey could be a sign of infection
- Accompanied by heavy bleeding & grey tissue is a sign of miscarraige

Usually, older period blood that took a little longer time to leave your uterus is grey to black.
