Wall Mounted Magnetic Suction Bracket



Place the magnetic bracket horizontally on the wall, mark the wall through the two small holes in the middle, fix the magnetic bracket at the marked position with screws, and then attach the rubber pad.

Pairing Remote To Motor



Change Motor Direction (If Needed)

First method:

Before continuing, check the motor direction by holding UP or DOWN. If the shade doesn't behave as expected, change the motor direction. This is only possible during initial set-up.



Hold Up and DOWN for 2 seconds



Shade will jog once

Change Motor Direction (If Needed)

Second method:

If the limits have already been set, the first method will not work. Please follow the second method.









Press PAIR/P

Shade will jog once

Press Up and DOWN

Shade will jog once

Set Top Limit



Hold Up tp move shade to desired limit



Hold UP and STOP together for 2 seconds to save



The shade will jog twice to indicate that the top limit has been set

Set Bottom Limit









The shade will jog twice to indicate that the bottom limit has been set

Hold DOWN to move shade to desired bottom position

Hold DOWN and STOP together for 2 seconds to save

Save Favorite Position

Step 01







Move shade to desired position

Press PAIR/P

Shade will jog once



Press and hold the STOP for 2 seconds; the blind will move to your favorite position. Repeat the same operation to cancel the favorite position setting.

Percentage Mode and Tilt Mode

Switch Between "Percentage Mode" And "Tilt Mode"

Note - The factory default is percentage mode.
Note - Dimming cannot be performed when the shade has not reached the maximum downstroke point.

Enter Tilt Mode:



Motor Operating Instructions In "Percentage Mode"

 \cdot When the emitter is in Percentage Mode, the percentage of window opening/closing can be controlled by rotating the control ring.





Open the shade by turning the Control Ring clockwise; when the lights are all on, the shade is fully open.



Close the shade by turning the Control Ring counterclockwise; when the lights are all off, the shade is fully closed.

Motor Operating Instructions In "Tilt Mode"

• When the emitter enters Tilt Mode, the light transmission of the blinds / wood blinds / ShangriLa shades can be controlled by rotating the control ring.



 Gently turn the control ring so that as the indicator lights up gradually in a clockwise direction, the shade increases the amount of light that can pass through;
 When the indicator lights up gradually along the counterclockwise direction, shade decreases

• When the indicator lights up gradually along the counterclockwise direction, shade decreases the light that can pass through.
