These are the highlights of the new features available in this week's Phoenix DPMS release.

Carestream Dental's 2017 Global Oral Health Summit






This week's release has been focused on getting ready for our annual user conference, the 2017 Global Oral Health Summit (GOHS). GOHS will be held in Orlando later this week, so we have been busy implementing some additional hard tissue charting functionality, various, performance tuning fixes and optimizations, addressing defects, and some general tidying up of the application for the show. Phoenix will be highlighted during the Opening Session as well as during the General Dental "Wine Down" plenary session. Of course, the Practice Management Pit Crew will be demoing Phoenix for the entire show.

Restorative Charting

This week's release introduces two significant advances to the support of hard tissue charting workflows, including the charting of existing restorations and the saving of the charting / clinical history. While limited to a subset of common restoration and treatment types, users can now begin to chart existing restorations against a patient's hard tissue anatomy including things like crowns, inlays, onlays, fillings, and root canals. The charting interaction works exactly the same as diseases and conditions, simply select the target hard tissue anatomy and apply the appropriate treatment or restoration that exists in the patient's mouth. We will continue to expand the library of restorations and treatments that can be charted in upcoming releases. This also begins the process of supporting current patient care workflow involving the documentation of completed (inside) work as patients get seen.



Additionally, hard tissue charting history is now saved and persists in the hard tissue chart. This marks the establishment of the patient's clinical history record. As mentioned in previous weekly release notes, as the user charts clinical findings, a record of automated chart history is also created (in addition to the visual representation of the charted event). Users can also search /

filter this charting history automatically by selecting anatomy or searching by tooth number. Future releases will include enhancements to the ability to search and filter the patient's clinical history.


Optimizations and Fixes

The following fixes and optimizations have been also been added to Phoenix this week.

- 1. Added message / notification when user selects anatomy that has no existing charting history.
- 2. Fixed a bug that interfered with the duplicate patient detection.
- 3. Addressed an issue with accessing the Scheduler Settings when a new location record is created.
- 4. Performance optimizations added to the Treatment Plan List UI to improve loading speed.
- 5. UI optimizations implemented in the Treatment Plan List UI to display the potential revenue / value of a patient's treatment plan and the number of outstanding procedures in the patient's treatment plan.
- 6. Fixed a bug in the Financial Activity module of Location Homepage which cause the wrong month's data to be displayed in the tooltip on hover.
- 7. Added a fix to the Recall List UI to address an issue in which the attachment in the email notification was not viewable.
- 8. Corrected a workflow issue that prevented the creation of a new connection (person) when creating a new Patient Record.
- 9. Fixed a defect that prevented the generation of the .PDF file when creating recall letter notifications via the Recall List UI.
- 10. Addressed an issue in the Post New Charges UI that prevented posting charges and updating the Patient Ledger in some cases.
- 11. Fixed a bug in the Treatment Plan UI where procedures would be duplicated and copies would be saved to the patient's treatment plan.
- 12. The patient's next scheduled appointment is now displayed correctly in the Treatment Plan List UI.
- 13. Addressed some issues and replaced the filter controls in the Treatment Plan List UI so that the correct subsets of patient with treatment plans are displayed.
- 14. Added a browser check utility from the Phoenix welcome email that will help to avoid issues when users try to access Phoenix from an unsupported browser.
- 15. Fixed a bug in the Treatment Plan UI in which sometimes scheduling the same procedures on a single appointment would create an issue with the Treatment Plan List.
