These are the highlights of the new features available in this week's Phoenix DPMS release.

Phoenix at the 2017 Global Oral Health Summit



This past week, several team members were busy spreading the news about Phoenix at our annual user conference, the 2017 Global Oral Health Summit (GOHS). Accordingly, this week's release was focused on ensuring that the demo environment was stable and ready for all the demos and presentations to customers and stakeholders. We received lots of interest and positive feedback during GOHS, recruited new Brain Trust members, and added new functionality requests to our backlog.

In the meantime, we have continued to implement bug fixes and performance improvements. Additionally, we have been advancing the backend work for the support of additional charting workflows and completing the testing for insurance estimation, which should be coming in the next few releases. This week we will also start actively identifying and recruiting potential Beta sites to run Phoenix live in their practices!

Optimizations and Fixes


The following fixes and optimizations have been also been added to Phoenix this week.

1. Fixed a bug that impacted the function of the patient search when booking an appointment.
2. Implemented a workflow optimization that defaults the cursor focus into the patient search field when creating a new appointment.
3. Addressed some internal bugs that were arising when trying to load the Location Home Page under certain conditions.
4. Fixed a UI issue in the Post New Payment screen to avoid occlusion of the balance information when the cursor focus is in the Amount Paid field.
5. Enhanced the patient search function to include searching against all patient phone numbers, not just the primary / preferred number in the Patient Record.
6. Implemented a workflow improvement to the Patient Record in which the insurance plan start / effective date (On Plan Since) is defaulted to the current date when adding new insurance to a patient's record.

- 7. The start / effective date (On Plan Since) now automatically resets to the current date when patient insurance is updated in the Patient Record.
- 8. Fixed a UI issue in which the help popup occludes the date selection control in form-based UIs (e.g., when defining the DOB in the Patient Record screen).
- 9. Squashed some bugs that occurred when updating the patient's insurance information via the Patient Home Page.
- 10. Addressed a workflow gap in which group procedures could not be added to the patient's Treatment Chart when defining or editing appointments.
- 11. Fixed a defect in the Patient Record which prevented saving or reverting changes when updating Insurance Payer or Plan records.
- 12. Addressed a UI issue in which the tab (location or patient) that is currently active (in focus) is no longer visually highlighted.
- 13. Fixed a defect that arose due to time zone handling when booking appointments in the late night / early morning hours.
- 14. Addressed an issue with date handling / calculation for events occurring at certain times of day based on the associated location's time zone.
