

Must start with level dry area!



Put cradles on ground



Find Center point of cradle. VERY IMPORTANT that first stave is same in each cradle.



Put bottom, stave with 2 round sides and Center it on cradle, 6" from and secure with 3" screw. Drain hole is still open



Do same at both ends. Stave must be centered.



Secure 3 left staves and 3 right staves in cradle with 3" screws. Make sure they are tight against each other

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Center door and insert into dado



Door should be straight



Screw right front wall and left front wall into place to finish front wall



Front wall finished. Make sure it does not fall at this point



Assemble back wall like you did on front wall with the 4" screws to connect




Center wall to Center of stave

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Use 1 stave for safety so walls don't fall



Start putting stave on each side with 3" screws. Do not bury the screw heads



Just put screw in as deep as shown. Bands will pull in rest tight later in process



Make sure each stave is tight against the previous stave



Do 10 staves on left side and 10 staves on right side and stop. Put floor in now and benches at this point



Put assembled floor in

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Fasten floor down with 2" screws on 4 corners VERY IMPORTANT to do benches next as they come over wall.



Using measuring sticks provided screw on 2x4 bench support. Do both sides same



2x4 bench support



Secure bench to wall with two 2" screws. One near front and one near back of bench



Finished look of benches installed



Continue to put rest of staves on and secure each one with a 3" screw. Remember to keep staves tight together

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Do not secure top 6 staves to allow movement for inserting top stave



Then massage them all down with rubber mallet softly



Set top in like this by lifting other two staves up a bit. Some little gaps will show. Do not screw these down. Ready for bands now



Place bolts of bands about 16-20" of ground to allow Place bands over top of the screw nails to cover room for roof boards.



holes, when a porch is added still put bands over screws at front wall

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Band placement on back

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While tightening bands hit staves lightly to get even tightness



Use 9/16" socket wrench and 9/16" combination wrench to tighten.



Do not over tighten to point of bending bolts.



21" from top of door to top of handle but also can be Inside handle goes across door at around 26" height your preference.



from top of door. Can use this as towel bar inside.



Center top bargeboard and screw on with 2" screws.

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Place bottom of bargeboards 1/4" below staves.



Bargeboards Tight together until bottom



Bargeboards bottom will have gaps



Put plastic membrane over wood staves and over each end. then neoprene strips then roof boards.



neoprene strips equal height off ground on both sides over the black plastic not onto wood. Then roof boards.




fasten near bottom to hold if needed.

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Center top 2 roof boards on Sauna



Use spacer boards for gap between roof boards, very Keep end of boards equal space to look nice important that screw goes through neoprene strip to seal





Put one screw in at each end so screw goes through neoprene strip and into roof stave. Keeps water seal




Use 1/4" spacers to put rest of roof boards on



Roof boards come down and cover roof membrane on both side for a nice look

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Set back rest in and screw in with 3" screws

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
