Despite what you might think, living greener doesn't have to cost a pretty penny. From personal care to items around the home and everything in between, there are countless products with eco-friendly ingredients and packaging, that are made with earth-conscious manufacturing processes. Here are some of my favorite recent finds.

## HAIRCARE

## Alodia Haircare



This Trichologist and Black-owned clean haircare brand specializes in products for textured hair. The products are packed with organic ingredients and all the packaging is made from 100 percent recyclable plastic or glass. I've been enjoying their Nourish & Hydrate Deep Conditioning Mask (\$18), which is currently on pre-order, and their Curl Enhancing Butter Cream (\$15.99).

## **Ecoslay**



Another brand I've enjoyed for curl care is **Ecoslay** (\$8-30). Their nourishing products feature a selection of natural ingredients and all products come in an eco-friendly pouch or otherwise sustainable packaging. Customers can send their empty packaging back through the Ecoslay Recycling Club for points toward future orders.

Something that is becoming increasingly common is that brands are removing water from their products. The reason is simple - water is heavy and requires bigger outer packaging. One category where we are seeing this is haircare. Three brands to check out are Viori, BRIXY, and Good Time, which also come in sustainable packaging.




