## The first survey of Leo Lionni's protean career as a graphic designer, children's book creator, and fine artist

Leo Lionni (1910–1999) was a key figure of postwar visual culture, who believed that a smart, pithy design language could unite people across generations and cultural boundaries. He first achieved success in the field of graphic design, serving as the influential art director of *Fortune* magazine from 1948 to 1960 and personally executing such innovative designs as the catalogue for the Museum of Modern Art's seminal photo exhibition *The Family of Man*. Then, in the 1960s, he embarked on an equally groundbreaking career in picture books, using tornpaper collages to illustrate tales such as *Frederick* and *Swimmy*, which are still beloved today. But even as his books won multiple Caldecott Honors, Lionni—who had begun as a painter—also maintained a richly imaginative fine art practice.

This volume, the catalogue of a major exhibition at the Norman Rockwell Museum, is the first to present Lionni's extraordinary career in the round. Written by leading scholars and with an introduction by the artist's granddaughter, it is illustrated with abundant examples of his work, including many little-seen items from the Lionni family archives. *Leo Lionni: Storyteller, Artist, Designer* will be an important, and eye-opening, contribution to the history of art and design.

## Stirring images of Greece and her people in a time of change, from a noted chronicler of the country

When photographer Robert A. McCabe first came to Greece as a college student in 1954, he found a country still scarred by the Axis occupation of World War II and the civil war that followed: poverty was widespread, and the infrastructure was underbuilt and battered. But, at the same time, these were years of hope: new ventures ranging from shipping lines to ice cream distribution heralded the nation's rapid development into a modern European state. And all around were visible the beauty of the Greek landscape, the splendor of the Greek archaeological heritage, and the optimism of the Greek people.


This volume collects the most compelling photographs that McCabe took in Greece between 1954 and 1965. Working in both black and white and color, he ranged through the mainland, the Peloponnese, and the islands, capturing scenes of a country on the brink of rapid change: a policeman directing traffic from a booth in the middle of an Athens intersection, before the city had traffic lights; a caique full of freshly harvested grapes landing at an island port; a performance of Euripides' *Hippolytos* in the ancient theater at the very first Epidauros Festival.

Furnished with meticulously researched captions and thoughtful essays, *Greece after the War* is an essential visual document of modern European history.

Robert A. McCabe has published fifteen photo books, most on Greece. Panagiotis Roilos is the George Seferis Professor of Modern Greek Studies at Harvard University and President of the European Cultural Centre of Delphi. 
