IMPORTING VARIABLE LABEL LIST FROM EXCEL/CSV

- 1. First convert excel to a CSV file
- 2. Open new label
- 3. Click on Add \rightarrow Variable Text \rightarrow Data Source

- 4. Add or remove prefix or suffix
- 5. Indicate the max number of characters you want
- 6. Check data source
- 7. Choose to import quantity column and data (QT/VALUE) or just data (VALUE, VALUE, VALUE)
- 8. Import data and click OK
- 9. Place text box where you want to on label
