






Colour in the magical sleigh full of Christmas presents!



Pip&Henry Activity 2 Decorate the christmas tree

Step 1) Colour in the Christmas decorations. Step 2) Cut them out. (Remember to be careful with scissors)



Pip&Henry Activity 3 Christmas biscuit baking

You will need an adult to help with this one.

INGREDIENTS:

225 g butter
225 g caster sugar 1 cup
1 egg
2 teaspoon vanilla
1 tablespoon lemon juice
1 teaspoon baking powder
450 g flour 3 cups




METHOD:

- Heat your oven to 160 degrees celsius.
- Cream the butter and sugar until as white as possible.
- Add vanilla, lemon juice and egg, beat.
- In a separate bowl whisk the flour and baking powder so that it is well combined.
- Add half the flour to the creamed ingredients, mix on low speed until combined, add the second half of the flour and mix on low speed until combined.
- Cover the dough in the mixing bowl with cling wrap, chill for 30 mins.
- Roll the dough to approximately 5-6mm thick.
- Use cookie cutters to cut the sugar cookie dough into whatever shapes you want. Place the cut-out shapes on a baking paper-lined cookie sheet.
- Bake your biscuits for 10 minutes, they should be lightly golden on the underside when they are ready.
- Cool the biscuits completely on wire racks before icing, or enjoy them plain.

Pip&Henry Activity 4 Christmas glasses

- Colour in your Christmas glasses.
- Cut them out (Remember to be careful when using scissors)
- Ask an adult to help you poke a whole through each dot.
- Tie a piece of string onto each whole.
- Tie the string around your head, There you have it!



Pip&Henry Activity 5 Christmas tree pinecones

- Go on an adventure and collect some pinecones.
- Paint your pinecones green.
- Colour in and cut out your Christmas decorations below.
- Glue the decorations to your Pinecone.



Pip&Henry Activity 7 Christmas tree Pizza

You will need an adult to help with this one.

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 roll Puff Pastry.
- Tomato paste.
- Grated Cheese (of your choice)
- Oregano, dried.
- Topping of your choice.



METHOD:

- Preheat the oven to 200°C (390°F).
- Roll out the puff pastry sheet and using a cookie cutter, cut out as many Christmas trees as you can. Transfer them to a sheet pan covered with parchment paper.
- With a fork, punch a few holes in the center of each Christmas tree.
- With a spoon, spread the tomato paste on the puff pastry trees, then sprinkle the grated cheese on top. Sprinkle some dried oregano and salt on top, to taste.
- If you would like to add any extra toppings (salami etc.) go ahead, just make sure all meat is cooked properly first,
- Bake in the preheated oven for about 15 minutes.
- They can be served either warm or room temperature..
