Lactobacillus produce lactic acid which can help make cheese, yoghurt, pickles, juice and bread.


GOOD BUG NAUGHTY BUG

How to make your own Compost!

YOU WILL NEED:

A bin with a lid

A well drained easy to access area

Compostable green ingredients

Scrunched up old newspapers

A gardening fork

INSTRUCTIONS

Carefully make holes in the lid of your bin. Ask your parents for help.

Start putting in your compost mix in the old newspapers with your green ingiedients like tea bags and veggies.

At least once a month, turn the contents of the bin over, using the gardening fork to let in more air. The more you do this, the quicker you make compost.

It can take 6 months to 2 years to get ready - but when it is, use it for your plants and garden!

DID YOU KNOW?

Earthworms are great for recycling to use in your compost! This rich soil will boost your flowers, plants and whole garden!









Tea bags, tea leaves, vegetable waste, grass cuttings straw, coffee grounds, plant prunings and eggshells.







You cannot put wood, cooked food, meat or bones, weeds, plastic or diseased plants into your compost bins.



ACTIVITY 9 DIY BIRD FEEDER



STEP 1:

Gather all your materials.

- 1)Toilet roll
- 2) Peanut Butter.
- 3) Bird Seeds



STEP 2:

Use a popsicle stick or butter knife to spread peanut butter on a clean toilet paper roll.



STEP 3

Roll the toilet paper roll on a plate filled with birdseed.

If desired, string a loop of hemp twine through the toilet paper roll.

Hang the toilet paper roll bird feeder on a bush, or slide it onto a branch. Your toilet paper roll bird feeder is complete!

STEP 1:
