



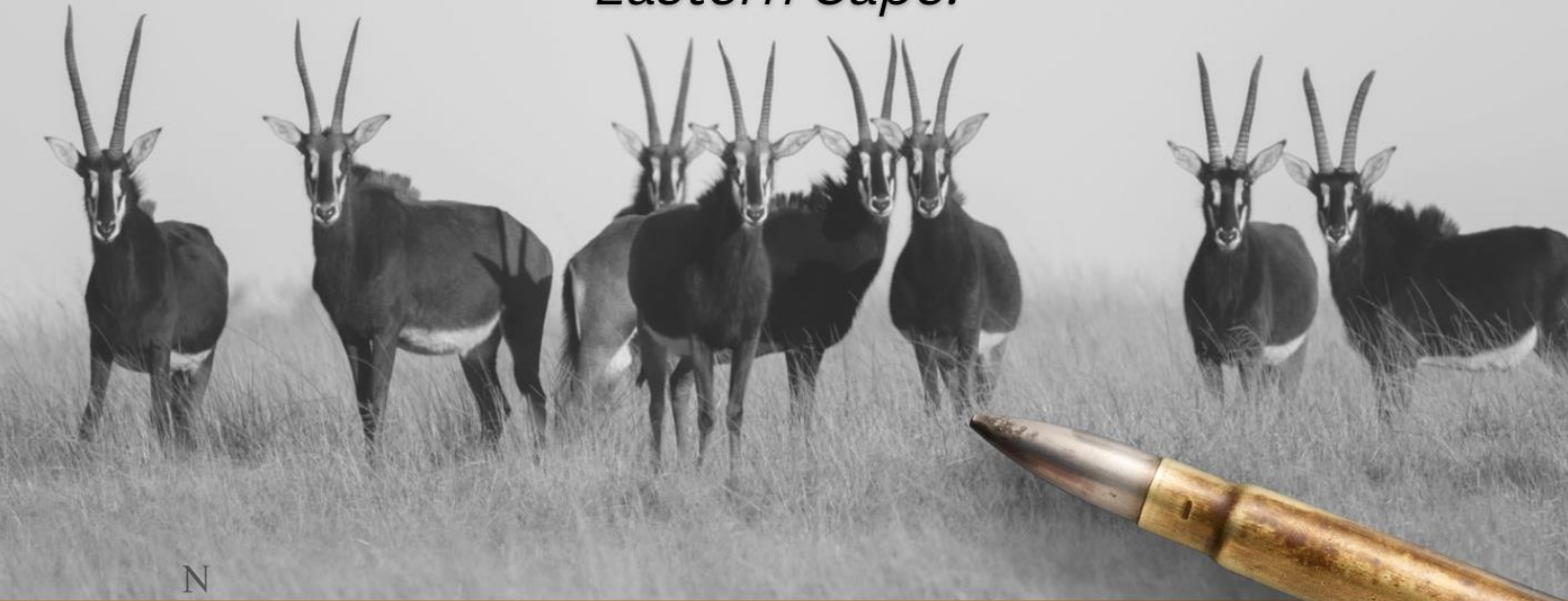

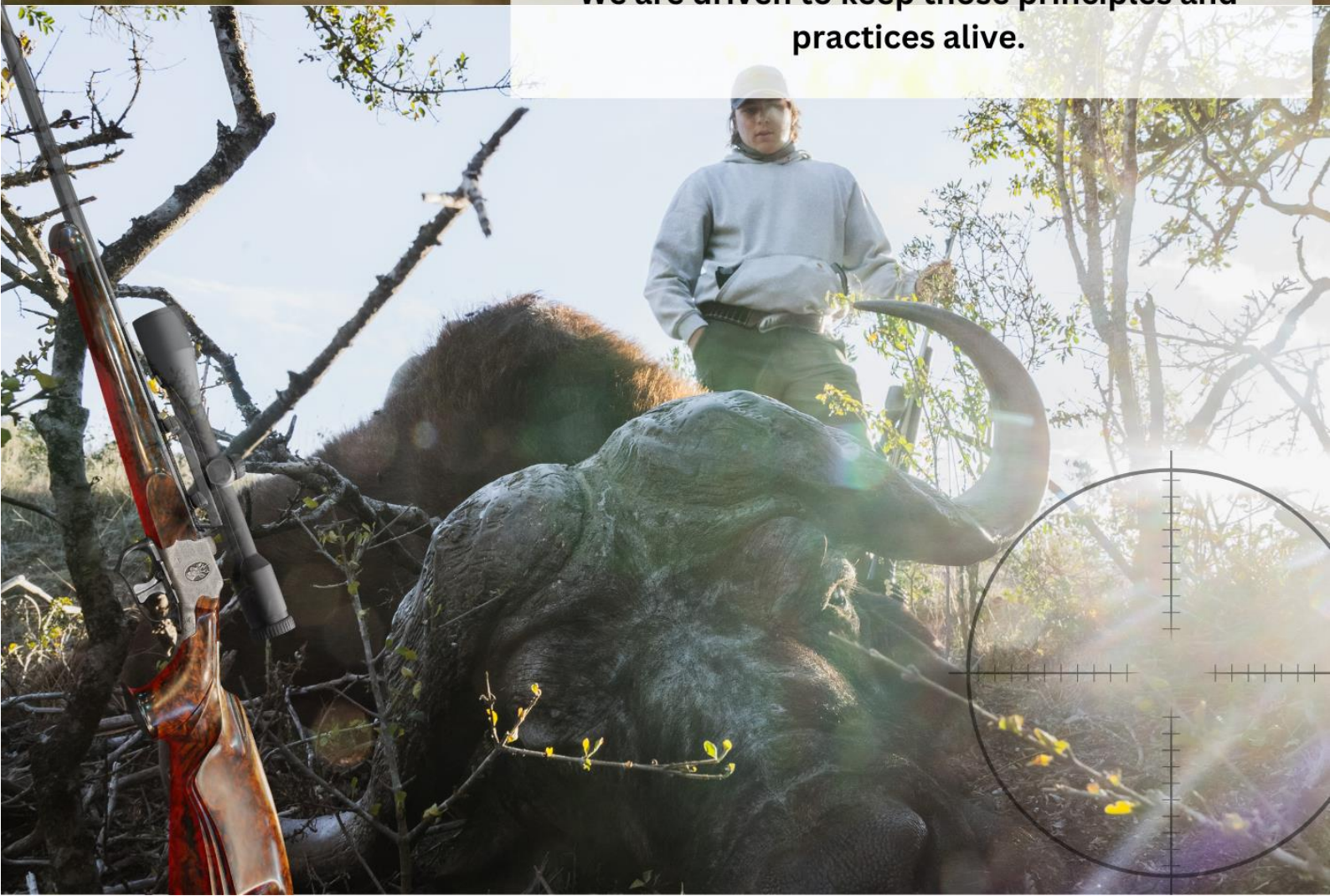

All our hunting is done by the method of 'walk and stalk' to experience the unique Eastern Cape Thicket, smell the fresh air and feel the African sun against your cheek. This fashion of taking on the elements and experiencing wildlife in its purest form ensures that the magnificent African animals get the respect and admiration they deserve.

Buffalo Kloof strives for nothing less than the ultimate safari experience. All hunting on the reserve is done according to the ethical, fair chase principles of our hunting heritage, which indeed preserve the integrity of the animal and the adventure of the hunt. Canned hunting, shooting from vehicles, or other practices contrary to fair chase are strictly prohibited. Buffalo Kloof is dedicated to the traditions that make African hunting the adventure of a lifetime. We are driven to keep those principles and practices alive.



Ethical Harvesting

Conservation with class and to harvest with thought.

Ethical Harvesting – is a term we have coined to describe our approach to hunting. This is a critical element in the sustainability of the reserve and maintaining healthy ecosystems, facilitating genetic diversity, and supporting surrounding local communities that rely heavily on the continued protection of our wilderness areas.





As part of our ecological management and sustainability model at Buffalo Kloof, we selectively harvest a set quota of animals every year. This is based on scientific observations considering, among others, carrying capacity, stocking densities, predator to prey ratios, and rainfall patterns. It is necessary to remember the importance of what hunters do for the conservation of wildlife. By visiting Buffalo Kloof you are choosing to support an effort to expand wilderness areas, allowing for bigger and safer spaces for wildlife to roam in their most natural form

Note: An observer is a guest which accompanies the hunter, if the group or guest would like to split and do other activities with another professional guide & private vehicle during the day such as private game drives, bush walks, photographic safaris, conservation activities etc, they are classified as an adventurer

Note: All wildlife veterinary interventions are undertaken for conservation reasons only and animal welfare is of primary concern. All funds raised are used to finance the operation and specific conservation objectives. Wildlife interventions are carefully planned with the conservation and veterinary team and must be pre-booked. Subject to availability. Rates can be split between the entire group. (Maximum group size: 10)

HELICOPTER TRANSFERS/ SCENIC FLIGHTS:

Port Elizabeth - Buffalo Kloof in Bell 407 helicopter \$2295

Aprox 50 minute flight along coastline, max 6 passengers (5 window seats & one middle seat best suited for children). Helicopter fitted with high visibility windows, guaranteeing unrestricted views. Luggage transport by road included.

Port Elizabeth - Buffalo Kloof in R44 Robinson helicopter \$1300

Aprox 1 hour flight along coastline, max 3 passengers. Luggage transport by road included.

30 minute flight around conservancy in R44 Robinson helicopter \$325

Bell 407 Helicopter hourly rate \$1350

R44 Robinson helicopter hourly rate \$650

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Pricing

- All prices are quoted in USD and are subject to change per annum
- A 15% Government regulated Value-Added Tax (VAT) on all daily rates and optional extras. VAT does not apply to trophy fees exported to USA.

Deposits

- A booking will only be secure once 40% of the total daily rate & species of the safari has been received as a deposit
- A minimum of 40% of the daily rate & species is required to confirm a booking, while trophy fees will be determined by the year in which the hunt takes place.
- Full payment of the balance of the total daily rate for the safari 6 months in advance
- Trophy fees can be settled at the end of the hunt.
- We do accept cash and all leading credit cards. Please note there may be a slight difference in credit card charges from time of payment to when the transaction takes place due to exchange rate fluctuations.

Surcharges on Transactions

- Credit Cards - A 3.5% surcharge will be levied on all credit card transactions.
- Wire Transfer - Free - 0% Surcharge (US Bank details will be provided)

Gratuities

- Tipping of camp staff, trackers, skinners, PH's can be done in USD cash
- Or tips can be added to your final safari bill
- Check with your Professional Hunter what the norm is on tipping and at all times keep in mind a tip is a bonus greatly appreciated, but not expected.

Insurance

- Buffalo Kloof recommends that all clients obtain travel insurance prior to your safari

Cancellation Policy

- In the event of a client cancelling a safari less than 3 months prior to the commencement date the safari, the deposit will be forfeited if the dates cannot be rescheduled to alternate dates within the same season, or the following season.
- Safaris cancelled more than 3 months prior to the commencement date of the hunt will be refunded the deposit less 25%. This 25% will not be refunded, but can be applied to a future safari with alternate dates within the same season, or the following season.

Wounded/ Harvested Trophies

- Any animal wounded/ hit, where blood is drawn, and found OR lost, will be considered taken. The full trophy fees will apply
