

OFF-LICENCE RENEWAL

Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 - Section 135

To VILLAGE DISTILLERY LIMITED

The **off-licence** in respect of the premises situated at **46A Commercial Street, Takaka** and known as "**Dancing Sands Distillery**" is renewed. Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **VILLAGE DISTILLERY LIMITED** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act. The present conditions of the licence continue to apply. These are as follows:

CONDITIONS

1. HOURS: Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
 - (a) **Monday to Sunday 9.00 am to 10.00 pm**
 - (b) No alcohol is to be sold on or delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
 - (c) A remote sale of alcohol may be made at any time on any day.
2. RESTRICTIONS:
 - (a) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed.
 - (b) The licensee must take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer of any alcohol, sold by remote means, is not under the purchase age.
3. WATER: While alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, free drinking water must be provided for customers at the tasting location.
4. LICENSED AREAS: The whole of the premises is designated as a Supervised area. The defined area is the area outlined on the plan received 14 February 2023.
5. SIGNAGE: Signage must be displayed at each point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons. The licence holders name, the licence number and the date on which the licence expires must be displayed on any internet site for remote sales, in any catalogue and printed on every receipt issued for alcohol sold remotely.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence expires on
