

## OET Writing 1-to-1 Course:

This OET Writing course is designed to provide targeted preparation for the Occupational English Test (OET) with a focus on all aspects of the OET writing exam. The syllabus consists of 4 classes: each class is profession-specific, ensuring that students receive tailored instruction relevant to their field, such as Pharmacy, where the focus will be, for example, on Pharmacy case notes, or Physiotherapy, where emphasis is on case notes from the OET Physiotherapy exam. Alongside profession-specific content, the classes will emphasize the key assessment criteria common across all OET professions, helping students to understand the skills needed to excel in the exam.

While the course follows a structured approach, the SET teachers adapt the lessons to meet the individual needs of each student, ensuring a personalized learning experience that maximizes their success in the OET.

The below syllabus is for the following professions:

*Pharmacy, Physiotherapy, Veterinarians, Dentistry, Radiography, Occupational Therapy, Podiatry, Speech pathology, Dietetics, Optometry*

## OET Writing Syllabus:

Session	Content	Assignment	Description
Class 1	CC Criteria & Letter 1	Write Letter (Letter 1)	In this class, students will be introduced to the OET Writing Criteria before being set their first assignment which should be discussed in class and then completed in personal time before the next session.
Class 2	Letter 1 Review & Plan Letter 2	Write Letter (Letter 2)	In this session, the student and the teacher will review letter 1 before the next assignment is introduced. After discussing the assignment in class, the student will complete letter 2 for their second assignment.
Class 3	Letter 2 & Plan Letter 3	Write Letter (Letter 3)	In the 3 <sup>rd</sup> session, the student and the teacher will review letter 2 before assignment 3 is discussed. After learning about what is required for assignment 3, students will complete it for their third assignment.
Class 4	Letter 3 & Review	Write final letter & receive written grade and feedback	In the final session, student and teacher will review letter 3, before discussing and learning about the requirements for the final assignment. Assessment here will be graded formally by our marking team and receive a grade plus explanations and corrections.
