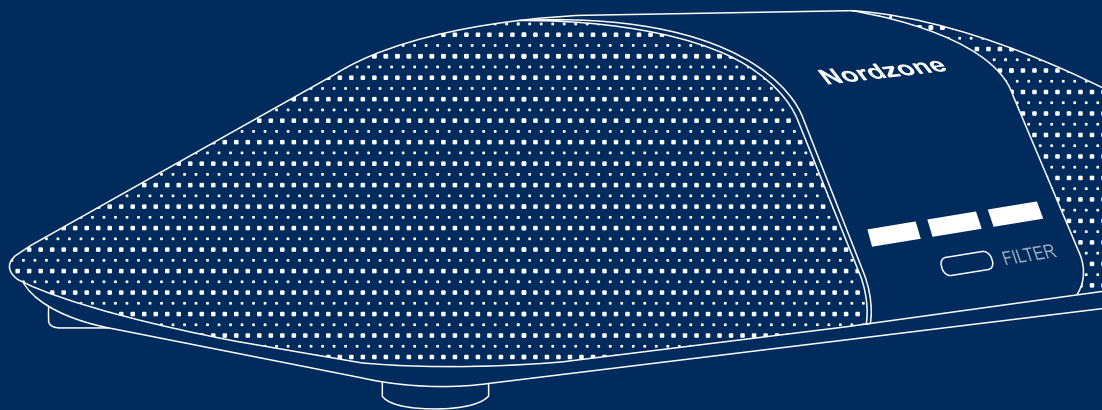
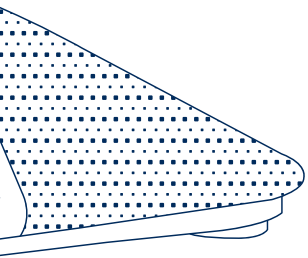

Safety instructions

- Do not spill any liquids such as water, detergents or flammable solvents on the device.
- Do not use Nordzone app when driving.
- Use only the mounting strap included in the box and ensure that the unit is securely fastened as specified. CabinAir take no responsibility for any harm or accident caused by improper installation, usage, disassembly and maintenance by any user or third party.
- To avoid injury, it is important not to install the unit in front of, or near the safety airbag which is normally located in the dashboard in front of the front passenger seat.
- Please do not adjust the settings or look at the display of the car air purifier whilst driving.

- Keep the power cable away from heated surfaces.
- No foreign objects should enter the unit as this may cause an electric shock or damage.

- Install the unit in a position where air can fully circulate around it - do not cover the unit.
- Install the unit in the appropriate position inside the vehicle by using accompanying accessories and according to the instructions in the user manual.
- Do not remove or replace the mounting strap that is delivered with the unit.

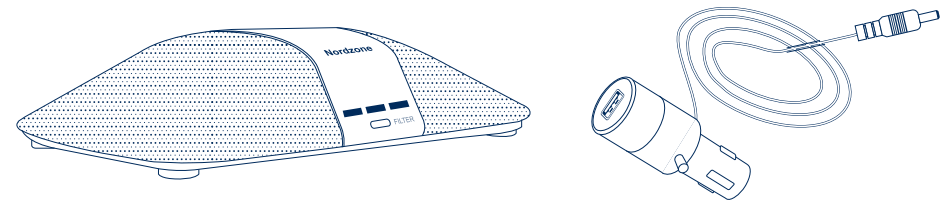
Nordzone™ Cabin air cleaner instructions

We believe you should have healthy air, no matter where you are, even in your car. So we decided to use our proven air cleaning technology to make a compact, but efficient air cleaner for your car.

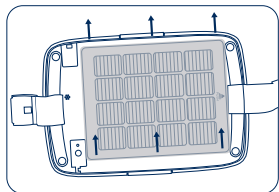
Your new cabin air cleaner cleans the air in 7 minutes and will effectively protect you from harmful airborne particles such as PM2.5, dust and pollen. We also added a layer with active carbon which absorbs unpleasant gases and odors to make your ride more pleasant.

The stylish but discrete Nordic design is ideal for the car interior.

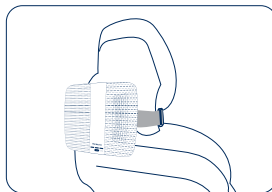
The air cleaner provides three choices for fan speed and is powered via 12V outlet. Plug is equipped with one extra USB port, so you can still charge your phone or other devices.



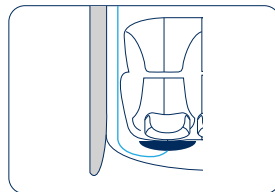
Getting started



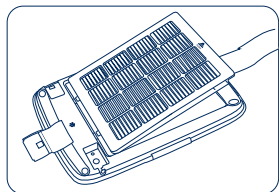
① Remove the plastic cover from the filter.



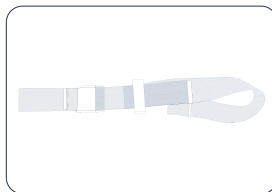
④ Firmly secure the unit behind a seat headrest



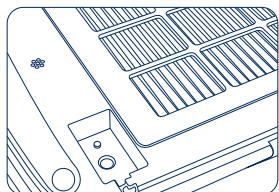
⑦ Hide the cable under carpets or other plastic details. To avoid cable damage when adjusting car seats, do not run too close to the seat tracks.



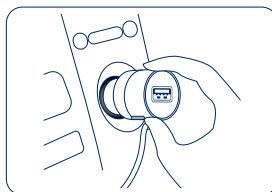
② Mount the filter from the back of the product.



⑤ Adjust the mounting strap accordingly and tighten the strap with the buckle.



③ Connect the power cable to the power supply port on the back of the unit.



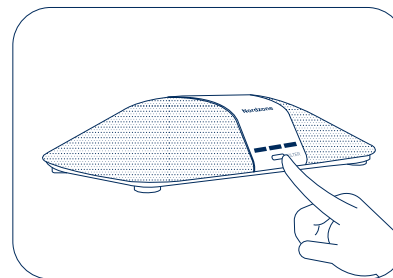
⑥ Connect the power cable to the power supply port, and then connect to the 12V outlet (cigarette lighter)

Getting started



IMPORTANT

The output of power connection must be 12V. The equipment automatically operates once it is powered; please press and hold the on/off button for 5s to disconnect from power (the unit beeps once) and press and hold the on/off button for 5s again to restore the power (the unit beeps twice).



① Press the on/off button lightly to change the speed of the air cleaner (in order of low, medium, high speed).



② Fan speed indicators represents:

One to three indicator lights represent the fan speed from low to high speed. When the filter has been used for accumulative 1,000 hours, the "FILTER" indicator lights up to prompt filter change.

Changing the filter

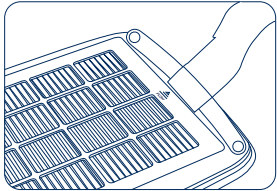

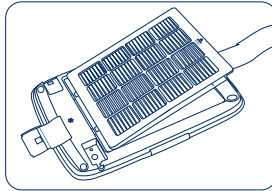
When the filter has been used for accumulative 1,000 hours, or unsealed for one year, it is suggested to change the filter.

Please change the filter to ensure the filtration effect.

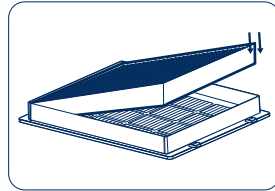
The product must be reset each time after the filter is changed:



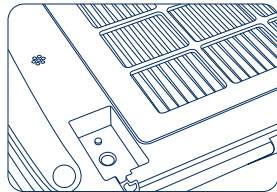
1 Disconnect the power, on the back of the air cleaner, press the mark on the filter cover lightly.



2 Remove the filter after the filter pops up.



3 Insert a new filter and close the bottom cover.



4 Connect the power, start the air cleaner, and press "Reset" near the power port to reset the filter records of the unit (press and hold for 7 seconds).

Buying the filter

Please contact the retailer to buy original filters to ensure the filtration effect.

Nordzone™ Air quality monitor

The Nordzone Air quality monitor measures air quality continuously, displaying the result on the light scale.

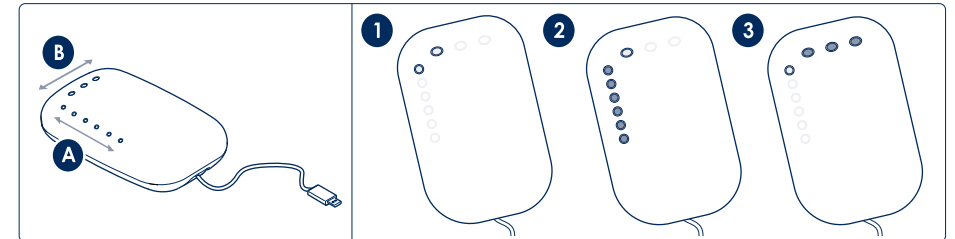
There are separate light scales, one for PM levels (A) and one for VOCs and CO₂ (B)

Interface

The Nordzone Air quality monitor measures air quality continuously, displaying the result on the light scale.

There are separate light scales, one for PM levels (A) and one for VOCs and CO₂ (B)

- White light = no action needed
- Orange light = pay attention and take action
- Red light = take immediate action.



- (1) Healthy air - no action needed.
- (2) Fresh air but not clean (increased PM_{2.5}) – close windows, temporarily activate recirculation mode.
- (3) Clean air but not fresh (increased VOC/CO₂) – open fresh air intake.

Installation and placement



IMPORTANT!

Do not cover the unit:

Place the Nordzone M Air quality unit in a position where the air can fully circulate.

Do not cover the unit: Place the Nordzone™ Air quality unit in a position where the air can fully circulate.

The Nordzone Air quality monitor should be placed inside the cabin where the driver can see the interface clearly without being distracted from driving. The bottom plate of the monitor is magnetic and has a high friction rubber surface, making it easy to attach to a magnetic holder (not included) or the center console. The Nordzone Air Quality monitor is connected via USB-C cable.

The Nordzone app

The app contains detailed information about your Nordzone System product. It indicates that it is working properly and displays the correct product version. When paired with Nordzone Air quality monitor the app compares real-time air quality data in-cabin and outdoors. It also shows historical data and gives recommendations for how air quality can be further improved.

Download the latest version of the Nordzone app from app store.

Care and maintenance

The stylish but discrete Nordic design of Nordzone™ Cabin is ideal for the car interior, and only high-quality material has been used. Regular cleaning is recommended to keep your unit in top condition.

- Disconnect the power from the back of the air cleaner before the cleaning or maintenance. It is recommended to use the vacuum cleaner to clean the air inlet from the inside when changing the filter.
- Wipe the exterior of the unit with a soft, clean, damp cloth.
- Never clean with gasoline, chemical solvents or corrosive material as these agents may damage the surface. Do not allow foreign objects to enter the ventilation or exhaust openings. This may cause electric shock or damage the unit.
- Do not try to repair or adjust any of the electrical or mechanical functions on your CabinAir unit yourself. Contact your local dealer or CabinAir for warranty information.

Under the following circumstances, it is suggested to change the filter:

- When the filter has been used for accumulative 1,000 hours, The "FILTER" indicator lights up to prompt filter change.
- After the filter has been unsealed for one year.



Troubleshooting

Condition	Recommendation
Nordzone™ Cabin air cleaner cannot be started.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Confirm that 12V power has been connected. ● Check the power cable to ensure good connection with the power outlet. ● Press the power button again. <p>Please contact the retailer if it still cannot be started.</p>
"FILTER" changing indicator is still on after the filter is changed.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Press and hold the Reset button for 7sec. If that doesn't help, re-install the filter. ● Press and hold the Reset button, hold for 7sec again. ● Please contact the retailer if FILTER changing indicator is still active.
The fan tops briefly.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● It is normal since the air cleaner is under the voltage protection. Sometimes, the voltage value changes, in this case, the fan or air cleaner will stop until the voltage is back to normal. ● Press the on/off button to restart.
I can still feel some odors, even though the air cleaner has operated for some time.	<p>Odor can be due to several factors.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Nordzone™ Cabin air cleaner is continuously purifying the air. Even so, new contaminants can be produced by car interior or drivers and passengers. Nordzone™ Cabin air cleaner can significantly reduce air pollutants. To accelerate the air purification process, you may increase fan speed to high-speed mode.
Nordzone™ Cabin air cleaner automatically operates when the car starts.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Nordzone™ Cabin air cleaner is set to automatically operate when the car starts. To change the setting, you may press the on/off button for 5-6s when it is on. Setting is changed successfully when you hear the air cleaner beep twice.
