TIPS TO MEASURE YOUR FEET

1. Print and measure (no printer? Go to step 2)

Take these freshly printed instructions, making sure the print scale is 100%. You can check that the proportions are correct by superimposing a credit card on the template we have drawn on the next page. Done?

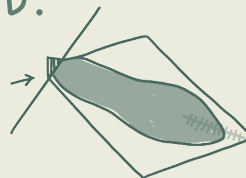
Good; now onto these following:

A.



WEAR A PAIR OF SOCKS THAT YOU USUALLY USE.

B.



FOLD THE SHEET AND PLACE IT ON A FLAT SURFACE.

C.



PLACE YOUR FOOT ON THE TEMPLATE, WITH YOUR HEEL RIGHT ON THE DOTTED LINE.

MARK THE SIZE OF YOUR FOOT ON THE SHEET.



Hi, here are the last 2 tips.



Measure both feet: you might get two different values (that's what we're like!), so consider the larger size. Relax your foot: you will get a more accurate measurement.

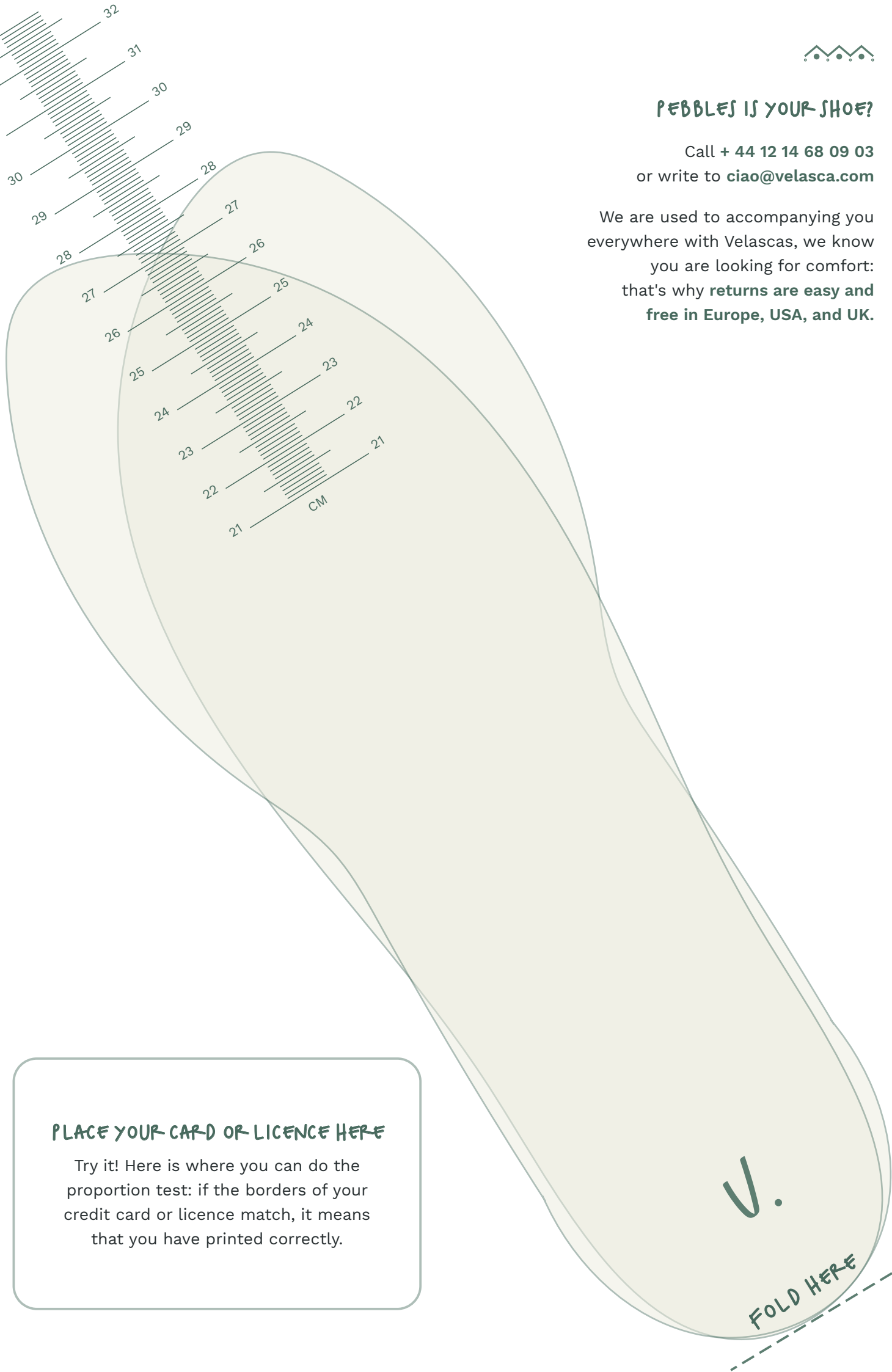

2. Just a spoonful of... pencil and ruler

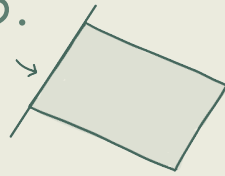
And a blank sheet of paper. Then follow these simple instructions:

A.



WEAR A PAIR OF SOCKS THAT YOU USUALLY USE.

B.



PLACE THE SHEET ON THE FLOOR OR ON A FLAT SURFACE. BETTER IF AGAINST THE WALL.

C.



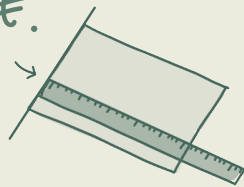
PLACE YOUR FOOT ON THE SHEET, KEEPING YOUR HEEL CLOSE TO THE WALL.

D.



MARK THE LENGTH OF YOUR FOOT ON THE SHEET: ONE MARK WHERE THE HEEL IS AND ANOTHER WHERE THE LONGEST TOE IS.

E.



REMOVE YOUR FOOT AND MEASURE THE LENGTH FROM THE HEEL TO THE TOE MARK.
