

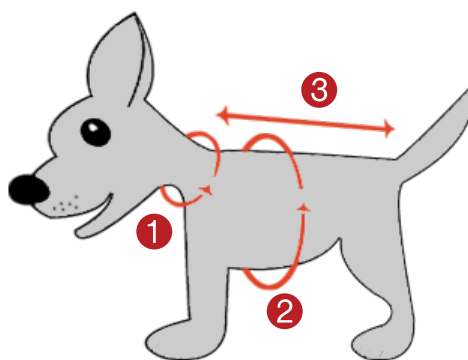
WITH SCISSORS AND TAPE

(or a stapler) you can magically turn this into a measuring tape!

- ① Cut the rulers, at left, apart on the dotted line.
- ② Tape the ends together following the numerical sequence of the inches.
- ③ When taped or stapled together, you will have a 36" measuring tape!

At Small Dog Mall the number one reason for a return is "It's the wrong size". Guessing your dog's size is not a good idea and is almost always wrong. So, take a moment to measure your dog before you order a collar, sweater or harness --- you will be glad you did.

HOW TO MEASURE YOUR DOG FOR A COLLAR, HARNESS, OR SWEATER



- ① NECK
- ② GIRTH
- ③ TOPLINE

FOR A COLLAR:

Place tape measure at the back of your dog's neck. Measure the circumference of the neck with two fingers under the tape. Remember, you want the collar to be loose enough to easily slide over your dog's head should they get caught on something. Round up to the nearest inch. **That's your dog's collar size.**

FOR A HARNESS:

You will need to know

- ① NECK and/or
- ② GIRTH

FOR A SWEATER:

You will need to know

- ① NECK and/or
- ② GIRTH and/or
- ③ TOPLINE (the topline is the length from back of neck to base of tail)
