#### Materials:

Fabric A: One 6.5" Vegas Strip Roll

Fabric B: 1 3/4 Yard Background


Cut (24) 9 1/2" Squares

Binding: 1/2 yard Backing: 3 1/2 yards

# **Sewing Instructions:**


#### Step 1:

Choose 18 strips from the 6.5" strip roll and lay them out into sets of 3's. Mix up the colors and patterns, putting the lighter strips in the center. Sew each set together using a 1/4" seam allowance, then press. You will have 6 strip sets.



### Step 2:


Cut off the selveges from each set, then cut (2) 18 1/2" blocks from each strip. You should now have 12 blocks.



### Step 3:

Take the 9 1/2" square from fabric B and mark a diagonal line down the center of each one, to snowball each pieced block from fabric A, place a square on the top left corner of a pieced block, RST, and sew across the diagonal line. Place a second square on the bottom right of the block and sew across the diagonal line.

Repeat with the remaining blocks, creating a total of 12 snowball blocks.




Trim the seam down to 1/4". Flip the edges of the squares and press.



## Step 4:

Lay out your blocks in a  $3 \times 4$  layout as desired. Sew each row together making sure to match up the snowballed points as you go.



Sew each row together, continuing to match snowball points as shown.
