# LEAF PLACEMATS

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## *FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:*

Top: 1 Jelly Roll (makes 6 placemats) OR  
1 Fat Quarter per placemat  
Backing: 1 Fat Quarter for each placemat  
Interfacing: 1/2 yard craftex (per placemat)

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## Fat Quarter Placemat:

Begin by Ironing wrong sides of fabric to either side of heavy stabilizer (use 505 Spray if stabilizer isn't iron on), making sure fabric is smooth. Tape pattern pieces together for the leaf shape template and cut out. Trace design onto one side of fabric unit and cut out all 3 layers at once. Add decorative stitching to placemat through all 3 layers as desired. Make sure edges of fabric are sealed well to craftex, edge stitch around all edges with decorative or satin stitch.



## Jelly Roll/Striped Placemat

Choose 8 strips from the jelly roll, and then 4 more of a contrasting color. Take the 4 contrasting colored strips and cut those in half lengthwise, creating (2) 1.25" x WOF strips from each.

Lay out all of your strips in desired order, alternating full size strips with half strips. Starting with a 2.5" strip sew all strips together lengthwise, creating one large unit that measures approximately 20" x 42" (WOF).

Take the large unit and split it in half (cut #1), creating 2 units that are approximately 20" x 21".

Once you've split that in 2, then you will split each piece at a 45 degree angle as shown (cuts 2 & 3).
