## Chips, Coins, and Tokens

## Materials:



Fabric A: 1 yard light color
Cut (10) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF
Fabric B: 1 yard medium color
Cut (5) 3 1/2" x WOF strips
Cut (10) 2" $\times$ WOF strips
Subcut: (200) 2" squares


Fabric C: 13/4 yard dark color
Cut (5) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips
Cut (7) $31 / 2 \times$ WOF strips for border

## Vegas Strip

Cut (50) 6 1/2" $\times 6$ 1/2" squares(suggested: 2-3 from each strip)

## Backing: 41/8 yard Binding:1/2 yard or Vegas Strips

## 4 Patch:

Medium set: Sew a strip from Fabric A to a strip from Fabric B, lengthwise.
Press towards the dark side and subcut the strip into $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide units.
Repeat 4 more times for a total of (50) 3 1/2" units.


Dark set: Sew a strip from Fabric A to a strip from Fabric C, lengthwise. Press towards the dark side and subcut the strip into 3 1/2" wide units. Repeat 4 more times for a total of (50) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ units.


Take a unit from the medium set and one from the dark set. Sew these pair together according to the diagram. Make 50 sets.


## Snowballs:

Mark each 2" square from Fabric B with a diagonal line. Sew a 2 " square onto each corner of the $61 / 2$ " block from the Vegas Strip fabrics, for a total of 50. Trim each corner, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam and press.


## Build the Rows:

Row A: Arrange a snowball and a medium 4 patch unit (with the dark side at the top left) together, repeating across the entire row, using a total of 10 units, as diagrammed. Make a total of (5) A rows with 10 units each.


Row B: Arrange a 4 patch unit (with the medium side at the top left) and a snowball unit together, repeating across the entire row, using a total of 10 units, as diagrammed. Make a total of (5) B rows with 10 units each.


## Build the Quilt Top:

Sew the rows together, beginning with an A row and alternating with a B row as you go.
