Sew Yeah Quilting

## Materials:

Fabric A \& B: 4" x $16^{\prime \prime \prime}$ rectangle
Cut one $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle
Cut sixteen $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 13 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Fabric D \& C: $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 25^{\prime \prime}$
Cut one $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle

Fabric E:


Cut eight 13/4" $\times 3$ " rectangles
Fabric F:
Cut four 3" squares
Fabric G:
Cut one 3" square


Fabric H: 21/2" x 25
Cut four 13/4" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

## Sewing Instructions:

1. Sew the $A$ and $D$ rectangles together along the long edge. Press. Cut the A/D strip into 8 segments $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$. Sew 2 A/D segments together as illustrated. Press. Repeat to make 4 four
 patches ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ ).
2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the $B$ squares. Place a B square on the top right corner of an E rectangle. Sew along the drawn line. Trim away excess fabric, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Press. Repeat to make 4 B/E rectangles ( $13 / 4$ " $\times 3$ ") .

Repeat this process placing the B square with the top left corner of the E rectangle. Repeat to make $4 \mathrm{~B} / \mathrm{E}$ reversed rectangles ( $13^{\prime \prime} / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ ).
3. Place a B square on the top left corner of an $F$ square. Sew along the drawn line. Trim away ecvess fabric, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Press. Repeat with another B square on the top right corner. Repeat to make 4 Unit 1 ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ ).
4. Sew an H rectangle to the left and right sides of the $G$ square. Press. Sew a C square to both ends of an H rectangle. Press. Repeat to make $2 \mathrm{C} / \mathrm{H} / \mathrm{C}$ sections. Sew the 3 sections as illustrated to make 1 nine-patch (5 1/2" x 5 1/2"). Press.
5. Sew a $B / E$ rectangle to the left side of a Unit 1 and a $B / E$ reversed rectangle to the right side as illustrated. Press. Repeat to make 4 (3" x 5 1/2").

6. Lay out pieces and sew as illustrated. Sew sections into rows. Press to complete the Daisy Chain Block (10 1/2" x 10 1/2").
