In this class you will learn the basic components of your embroidery machine, features and basic functions on your model. You will learn about needles, threads, stabilizers & necessary embroidery tools that every embroiderer must have to achieve great results.

SUPPLY LIST:

- Embroidery Machine [or combo machine], embroidery module, hoops, power cord, any and all accessories and MOST IMPORTANTLY your OWNERS MANUAL
- 40 wt Embroidery Thread-at least 4 colors
- Bobbin Thread-60wt OR you can use the same upper weight thread.
- 2 fat quarters that are either solid or have a small print [you can purchase these in store]
- 1 Yard Fusible interfacing SF101
- Medium Weight Cutaway Stabilizer
- PolyMesh aka No Show Mesh
- 505 Temporary Adhesive Spray
- USB Stick
- Scissors/Shears or rotary cutter [for fabric cutting]
- Embroidery Scissors
- Seam Gauge
- Quilting ruler...if you have one
- Notebook & pen to take notes

NOTIONS:

- Needles: sizes 75/11 & 90/14
- Seam Ripper [if your machine didn't come with one]

- Thread stand [optional but very handy]Travel iron and mat [optional]Water and/or snacks
