## Materials:

Fabric A Vegas strip set (20-61/2" x WOF strips)
Cut each strip into (12) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2$ " rectangles for a total 240.
Fabric B 1 Vegas strip ( $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip)
Cut this strip into (4) 11/2" strips.
Fabric C 4 yards background
Sub-cut to total (480) $31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2$ " squares.
Binding: 5/8 yard
Backing: 4 yards

## Sewing Instructions:

Step 1 Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Background Fabric C squares. With right sides facing, layer a Fabric C square on the left side of a Fabric A rectangle.
Stitch on the drawn line and trim $1 / 4$ " away from the seam. Press open.


Step 2 Repeat on the right side. Make (6) Partial left units from each of the Fabric A strips.


Step 3 Sew the Partial left units from each Fabric A strip to make a Left Unit. Press open. Repeat for each Fabric A strip.


Make 20 Left Units

Step 4 With right sides facing, layer a Fabric $C$ square on the right side of a Fabric $A$ rectangle. Pay attention to the diagram, Steps 4 to 6 are a mirror image of Steps 1 to 3.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $1 / 4$ " away from the seam. Press open.


Step 5 Repeat on the left side. Make (6) Partial right units from each of the Fabric A strips.


Step 6 Sew the Partial right units from each Fabric A strip to make a Right Unit. Repeat for each Fabric A strip. Press open.


Make 20 Right Units

Step 7 Sew the Left Unit and Right Units together. Repeat for each set from the Fabric A strips.


Make 20 Blocks

Step 8 Arrange the Blocks in rows as shown, flipping each block $180^{\circ}$ back and forth. Sew rows together.


Step 9 Sew Fabric B strips end-to-end and sub-cut to (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 72 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Sew on either side of the quilt top.
