

## Jack in the Box



10" x 10" Finished

## Materials:



Fabric A: 4 x WOF

Cut (8) 3" squares



Fabric B: 4 x 21

Cut (4) 3" squares



Fabric C: 4 x 21

Cut (4) 3" squares




Fabric D: 3 x 21

Cut (4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles



Fabric E: 4x4

Cut (1) 2 1/2" square



## **Sewing Instructions:**

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) A squares. Use (4) squares in the second step. Set (4) squares in step two. Set (4) squares aside for step 3.

Place (4) A squares with (4) B squares, right sides together. Sew a 1/4" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line on each set of squares. Cut along the drawn diagonal lines, making (8) A/B HST units. Trim HST units to measure 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" unfinished.











Repeat HST unit assembly to make (8) A/C HST units.

Arrange the HST units with the remaining cut pieces (D and E) to form another block. Note the rotation of HST units in each corner.

Sew the block together as shown. Arrows indicate pressing instructions. Once complete, the block should measure  $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
