Materials:



Fabric A: 12 Colored Fat Quarters

Trim each FQ to 18" x 18" square



Fabric B: 6 yds contrast

Cut (12) 18" x 18" squares Cut (8) 17 1/2" squares Cut (1) 35" x 35" square

Binding: 3/4 yard Backing: 9 1/4 yard

Create 24 Half Square Triangles:

On the wrong side of each 18" square of fabric A, mark a diagonal line from corner to corner. Place each of the marked Fabric A, RST with the 18" squares of Fabric B. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on both sides of the marked line. Cut along the marked line, between each seam. Open and press creating 2 HST from each unit. Square up each HST to 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".













Create 8 Flying Geese:

Pair up 8 of the matching HST, with the color sides together. Sew them together and press open.



Lay all of the blocks out according to the diagram, placing colors as desired. Sew each row together.
