

Materials:



Fabric A: 1 Colorful 6 1/2" Strip Roll by Sew Yeah Quilting

Choose 14 strips, set the rest aside for a scrappy binding



Fabric B: 1 Solid 6 1/2" Strip Roll by Sew Yeah Quilting

Cut (14) strips into 26" lengths

Backing: 5 1/8 yards

Sewing Instructions:

Join a colored and a solid strip on both ends to form a ring.

Cut through the colored part of the ring, somewhere between the middle and about 10" from the solid strip. Make this same cut for all the strips at random lengths. You may lay them out as you go to get an idea of where you want to split them for a staggered and varied look.

Once you have the strips layed out as desired, sew them together lengthwise.
