Materials:



Fabric A:

Cut one 2 1/2" square



Fabric B:

Cut one 2 1/2" x 12" rectangle



Fabric C: 6" x 6"

Cut four 2 1/2" squares



Fabric D, E, F: 4" x WOF

Cut four 3" squares
Cut four 2 1/2" squares
Cut one 11/2" x 12" rectangle



Fabric G: 4" x WOF

Cut four 3" squares



Fabric H: 3 1/2" x 11"

Cut one 11/2" x 12" rectangle


Sewing Instructions:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the G squares. Align the D and G squares, right sides together. Sew along both sides of the drawn line with a 1/4" seam allowance. Cut along the drawn line. Makes two half square triangles (HST). Open and press both HSTs. Trim HST units to measure 2 1/2". Make a total of 8 HSTs.





2. Place the B and F rectangles right sides together and sew along the length. Press. Place the H rectangle on the B rectangle right sides together and sew along the length. Press. Trim the strip set into four 2 1/2" segments.



3. Lay out pieces and sew as illustrated below. Sew sections into rows. Press to complete the Lynx block ($10\ 1/2$ " x $10\ 1/2$ ").
