## Materials:

## Fabric A:

Cut one 2 1/2" square
Fabric B:
Cut one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle
Fabric C: 6" x 6 "
Cut four 2 1/2" squares


Fabric D, E, F: $4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF
Cut four 3" squares
Cut four 2 1/2" squares
Cut one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle

## Fabric G: 4" x WOF

Cut four 3" squares
Fabric H:31/2" x ll"
Cut one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle

## Sewing Instructions:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the $G$ squares. Align the $D$ and $G$ squares , right sides together. Sew along both sides of the drawn line with a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Cut along the drawn line. Makes two half square triangles (HST).
 Open and press both HSTs. Trim HST units to measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make a total of 8 HSTs .
2. Place the $B$ and $F$ rectangles right sides together and sew along the length. Press. Place the H rectangle on the B rectangle right sides together and sew along the length. Press. Trim the strip set into four 2 1/2" segments.

3. Lay out pieces and sew as illustrated below. Sew sections into rows. Press to complete the Lynx block (10 1/2" x 10 1/2").
