

Nine Patch Star



10" x 10" Finished

Materials:



Fabric A: 4" x WOF

Cut 12 2 1/2" squares




Fabric B: Fat 1/8"

Cut 9 2/1" squares



Fabric C:

Cut 4 - 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles



Sewing Instructions:

- 1. Lay out 4 A squares and 5 B squares in a nine patch. Sew the squares into rows. Sew the rows together to make 1 Nine Patch unit $(61/2" \times 61/2")$. Press seams as shown.
- 2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each remaining 8 A squares.
- 3. Place an A square on the left end of a C rectangle, right sides together. Sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" from sewn line and press open. Repeat on the right end of the rectangle to make a Star Point unit (21/2" x 61/2"). Repeat to make 4 Star Point units.
- 4. Lay out the remaining 4 B squares, 4 Star Point units and the Nine Patch unit in a nine patch. Sew the pieces into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the Nine Patch Star Block $(101/2" \times 101/2")$. Press seams as shown.



















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
