## Materials:



Fabric A, C:
Cut four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
Cut two $27 / 8$ " squares


Fabric B:
Cut eight 11/2" squares

Fabric D:


Cut eight 2" squares

Fabric E: 5" x 21 "
Cut one 3 1/2" square

Fabric F, G, H, I, J: 6" x WOF
Cut two $27 / 8$ " squares
Cut eight 11/2" squares
Cut eight 2" $\times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
Cut eight 2 1/2" squares
Cut four $2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

## Sewing Instructions:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the $D, F$, and I squares.
2. Place one $F$ and $C$ square right sides together. Sew $1 / 4$ " on either side
 towards the C square. Trim each square to $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat to make 4 half square triangle units (HST).
3. Place one D square on the left end of one J rectangle, right sides together. Sew along maked line, and trim, leaving $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Press towards the D square. Repeat with other side, and trim flying geese to $2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat to make 4 flying geese units.
4. Place one I square on the left end of the one A rectangle, right sides together. Sew along marked line, and trim, leaving $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Press towards the A rectanlge. Repeat with other side, and trim tall flyinggeese to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat to make 4 tall flying geese units.

5. Sew each $B$ square to a $G$ square, and press the seam towards the $B$ square. Sew two $B / G$ set together in a four patch. Press seam open. Repeat to make 4 four patches.

6. Lay out pieces, and sew into 9 patch sections, as illustrated. In corner units, press towards H rectangles when sewing into rows, and then press seams open when rows are sewn together. Sew flying geese units together, and press seams open. Sew sections into rows, and press seams according to arrows. Sew rows together, and press away from center to complete the Reach for the Stars Block (10 1/2" x 10 1/2").
