OBJECTIVE:

In this class you will learn the basic parts of your sewing machine, basic machine stitches and how to achieve those with the specialty feet that came with your machine. You will also learn about needles, thread & fabric and the relationship between them.

- 2 fat quarters that are either solid or have a small print [you can purchase these in store]
- 1 Yard Fusible interfacing SF101
- <u>Scissors/Shears</u> or <u>rotary cutter</u> [for fabric cutting]
- <u>Thread snips</u> [for threads]
- <u>Measuring tape</u>
- <u>Seam Gauge</u>
- Quilting ruler...if you have one
- Notebook & pen to take notes

NOTIONS:

- Needles: sizes 80/12 and 90/14
- Seam Ripper [if your machine didn't come with one]
- Thread stand [optional but very handy]
- Travel iron and mat [optional]
- Water and/or snacks
