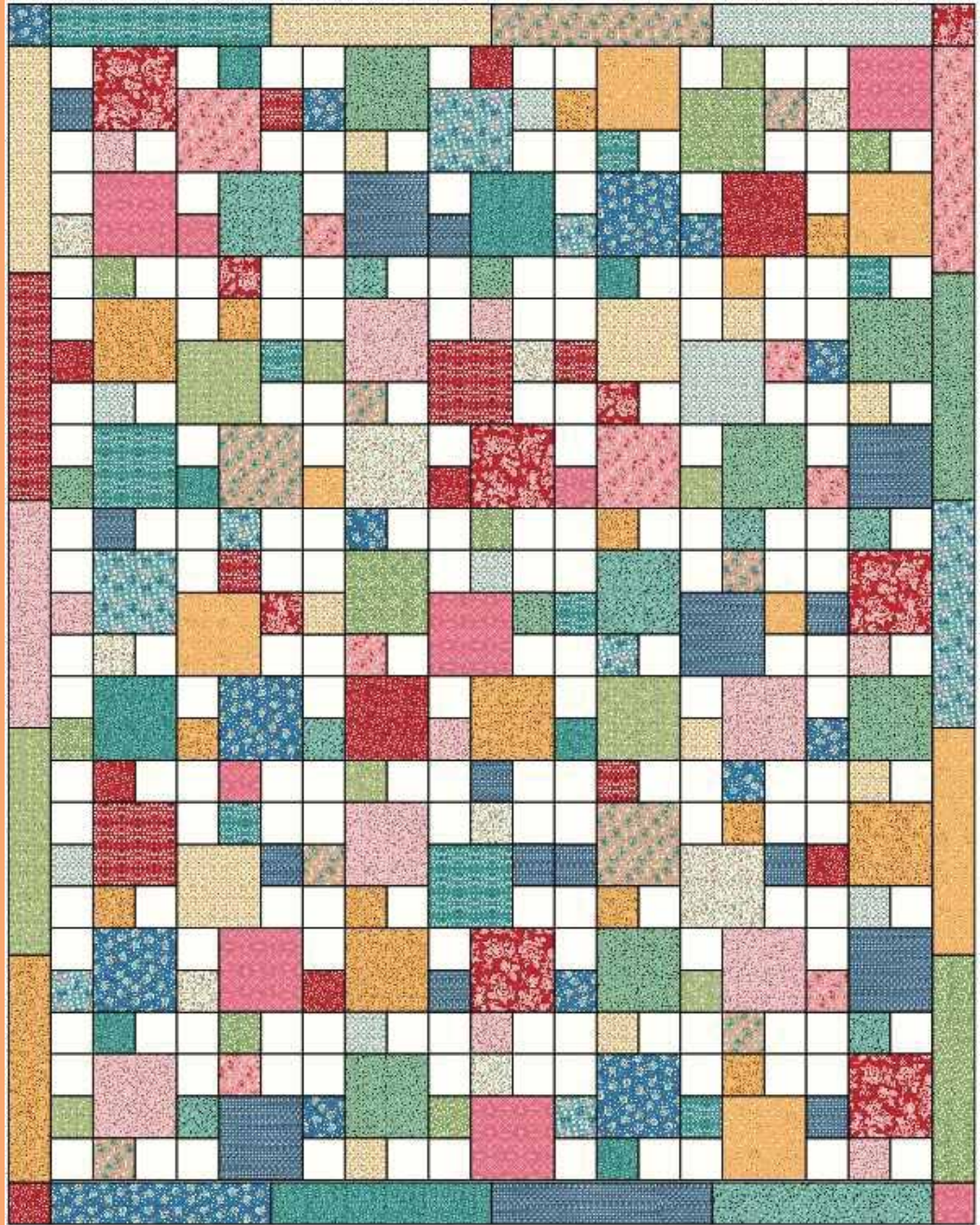


Scrappy Patches



Materials:



Fabric A: 1 Vegas Strip Pack

Cut (3) 6 1/2" squares

Cut (6) 3 1/2" squares

Cut remainder into 3" strips for a scrappy border



Fabric B: 1 3/4 yards background

Cut (189) 3 1/2" squares

Binding: 5/8 yard

Backing 2 1/2 yards 108" wide

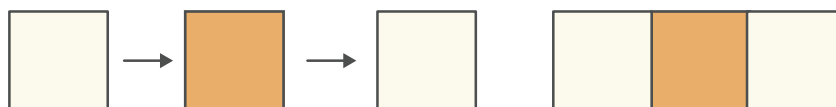
Note: Each block is made with (1) 6 1/2" print square, (2) 3 1/5" print squares, and (3) 3 1/2" background squares.

Sewing Instructions:

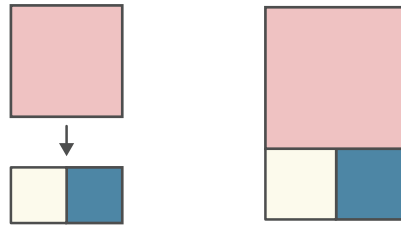
Begin by making (63) 2 patch units by pairing a 3 1/2" print square with a 3 1/2" background square as shown. Chain piece these for faster construction. Make 63 pairs altogether.



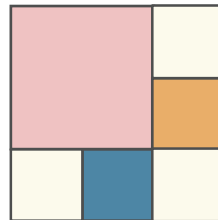
Now, join the remaining 3 1/2" print squares and 3 1/2" background squares to make (63) 3 patch units.



Next, sew together a 2 patch unit from step 1 with a 6 1/2" square as shown. Make 63 units.



Finally, sew the 3 patch unit to the unit made in step 3 as shown. Chain piece to make 63 blocks. These should measure 9 1/2" square.



Join blocks into rows of seven, make nine rows. Press each row in the opposite direction, and stitch together. Sew the 3" scrappy border strips and attach to the quilt top.
