## Splice

## Materials:



Fabric A: $4 \times \mathrm{WOF}$
Cut (2) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Cut (4) 3" $\times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
Fabric B: $4 \times 2 \mathrm{l}$
Cut (4) 3" squares
Fabric C: $4 \times 2 \mathrm{l}$
Cut (4) 3" squares


Fabric D: $5 \times 5$
Cut (1) 3 1/2" square

## Fabric E: $5 \times 5$

Cut (1) 3 1/2" square
Fabric F: $4 \times 8$
Cut (2) 3" squares
Fabric G: $4 \times 8$
Cut (2) 3" squares

## Sewing Instructions:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) A squares. Set (1) A square aside for the third step.

Place (1) A square with (1) E square, right sides together. Sew a 1/4" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut along the drawn diagonal line, making (2) A/E HST units. Trim HST units to $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.


Repeat HST unit assembly to make (4) D/H HST units.


Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) C squares and (4) D squares.
Place (1) D square onto the top left corner of (2) B rectangles, right sides together. Sew along the drawn diagonal lines. Trim excess corner fabric to a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Press toward the corners.

Repeat SNF techniques to attach (1) C square to the top right corner of the same (2) B rectangles to complete (2) flying geese units measuring $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.


Repeat flying geese unit assembly to make (2) units with opposite fabric placement. Reference diagram to the right.


Arrange HST units, flying geese units, (2) G squares and (2) H squares to form the block.
Sew the block together as shown. Press seams away from flying geese units. Once complete, the block should measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" unfinished.
