


## Materials:

## Fabric A: 1 Vegas Strip ( $21-61 / 2$ " strips)



Fabric B: $21 / 4$ yard background
Cut (11) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strip

Backing: $52 / 3$ yards
Binding: $2 / 3$ yard

## Sewing Instructions:

## Strip $1:$

Make 6 of the following sets: Choose 2 vegas strips and 1 background strip.
Sew them together along the length as pictured. Press.


Subcut this new strip set into (6) $6 \frac{112}{2}$ units. Repeat and set aside.


## Strip 2:

Make 3 of the following sets: Choose a Vegas strip, a background strip and another Vegas strip. Sew them together along the length as pictured. Press.


Subcut this new strip set into (6) $61 / 21$ " units. Repeat and set aside.


To maximize variety in your blocks, split the remaining 3 Vegas strips in half at the 21 "point. Now take these shorter strips, mixing them up and create 2 more of the Block 1 set and 1 more of the Block 2 set. Subcut those into the $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " units.

## 9-Patch Blocks

Gather (2) different Strip 1 units, and (1) Strip 2 units. Lay them out as pictured, creating a 9-Patch Block.


Repeat, mixing up all of the units for a scrappy look. Make a total of (20) 9-Patch blocks.

Lay out the 9-Patch blocks as desired in a $4 \times 5$ grid. Sew rows together, matching seams.
