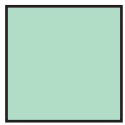




SCRAP-FILLED DOG BED

SUPPLIES:



1 yard

1 yard x 24"

Inner Fabric



3 Yard

Cotton rope or paracord



1 yard

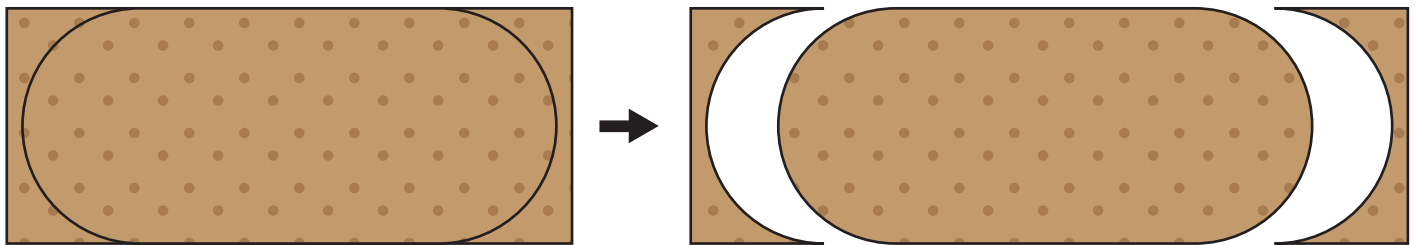
1 yard x 24"

Outer Fabric

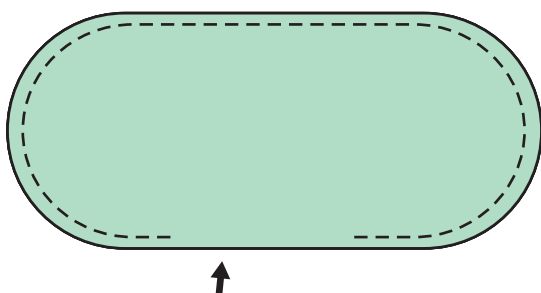
For this pattern we will be making a small to medium sized dog bed. If you would like to create a larger dog bed, increase your measurements.

STEP 1:

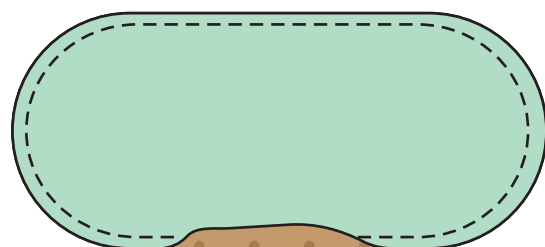
Cut the same size oval out of your inner and outer fabric. Our oval was cut from a 1 yard x 24" rectangle.



Place your two ovals right sides together. Sew 1/2" around the entire edge, leaving a 7" gap. Flip right side out, and topstitch 1/2" from the edge.

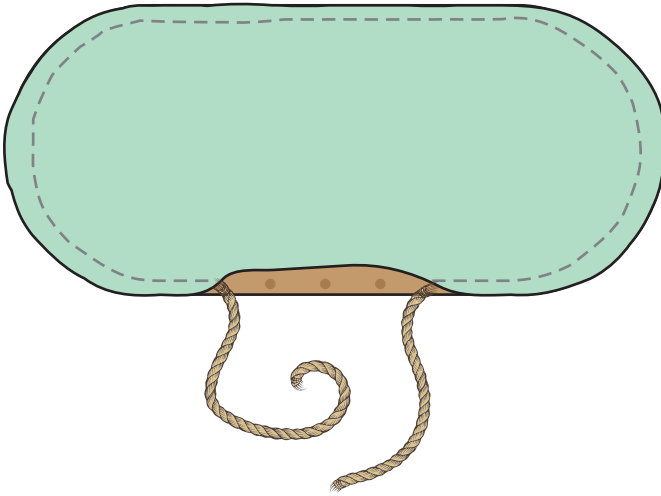


Right Side out

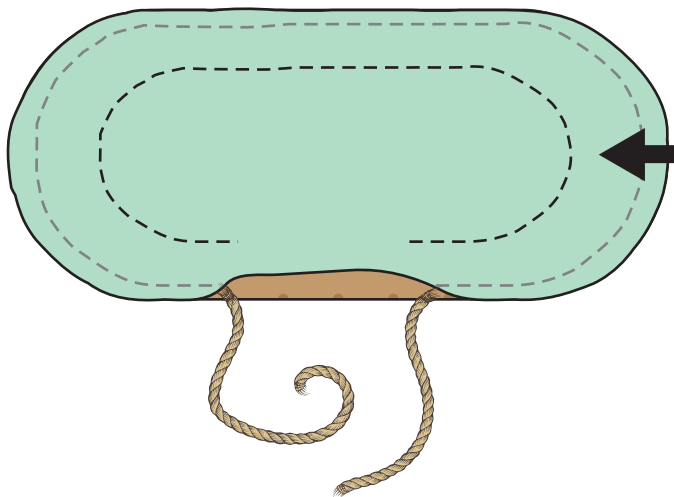


STEP 2:

Thread your rope or cording through the 1/2" seam you just sewed.



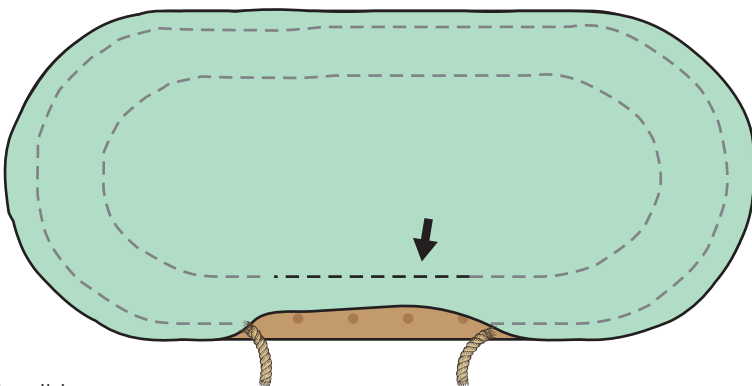
Then, sew an oval seven or more inches in from your seam. You can mark this or eyeball it. Be sure to leave a 7" gap exactly where your pre-existing gap is.



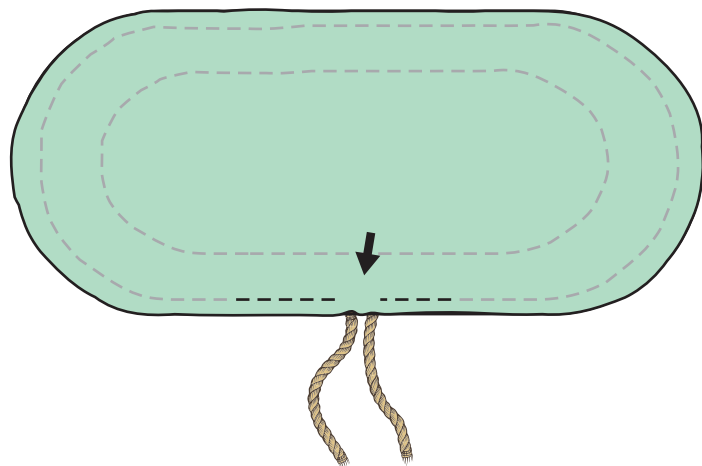
Important to leave gap big enough to fit your hand

STEP 3:

Time for stuffing! First stuff the inner oval of your dog bed. Use scraps of fabric or polyfill as desired. After the inside is full, close the gap with a topstitch.



Next, stuff the outer circle. Once it is full, sew the gap closed with a topstitch. Sew close to your rope, but do not sew over it.



Finally, pull the ropes tight to bring up the edges of your dog bed. Tie off the rope and trim the excess.
