 One button to operate Tend
 Turn your Tend on: click the button
 Change the intensity: click the button
 Change the pattern: once you reach the highest speed, continue to click the button to discover the different patterns
 Your Tend has a smart battery level indicator that will start to flash when your Tend's battery is down to 10%
 Turn your Tend off: Hold the button for 3 seconds
 Charge your Tend: untwist the product in the middle of the unit. Insert the charger, flashing button light indicates the product is charging. When the light stops flashing and is continuously on the product is charged

Tend Safety Instructions
We strive to make the Tend as safe as possible. This is an advanced mechanical tool with electric components. If the Tend and its accessories are not used or maintained properly, there is a risk of fire, electric shock, or injury. When using the Tend, these basic precautions should always be followed including:

USE ONLY AS INSTRUCTED. Use the Tend as described in this Instruction Manual. Use only Tend recommended accessories and replacement parts. Do not carry out any maintenance other than as advised by Tend.

NOT FOR CHILDREN. The Tend and charger are not intended for use by young children or persons with reduced physical, sensory or reasoning capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction by a responsible person. Do not allow the Tend to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when used by or near children. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the Tend or charger.

REDUCING RISK OF INJURY. Charge the Tend only using the Tend charger. Other chargers may cause personal injury or damage. Tend is designed for external use only. Do not use on irritated skin. Do not use if you have a cemaker

WATERPROOF. Tend is waterproof rated IP67. To ensure wat make sure the body is screwed tightly closed before using in sure the button is not damaged before using in water To ensure waterproofin

CHARGING LOCATIONS. The Tend should be charged indoors in a well ventilated, dry location. Do not charge the Tend outdoors, in a bathroom or within 10 feet (3.1 meters) of a bathtub, pool or standing water. Do not use the Tend charger on wet surfaces and do not expose the charger to moisture, rain, or snow. Do not use the Tend or charger in the presence of explosive atmospheres (gaseous furnes, dust, or flammable materials). Sparks may be generated, possibly causing a fire.

UNPLUGGING THE CHARGER. Keep the cord from heat, oil, and sharp edges. Do not use or charge with a damaged cord. Do not stretch the charger cord or place the cord under strain. Keep cord away from heated surfaces. Do not handle the charger, including the charger terminals with wet hands.

CHARGER CARE. Unplug the charger when not in use. Unplug the charg from the outlet when not in use for extended periods. Make sure the charger cord is located so that it will not be stepped on, tripped over, or otherwise subjected to damage or stress. Have a damaged charger replaced immediately. charger

DO NOT OVERCHARGE. Do not leave Tend charging for more than an hou after the battery has been fully charged. The battery includes a protection system to avoid the risk of overcharging. However, overcharging may educe its life over time

DO NOT BURN OR INCINERATE THE TEND OR ITS BATTERY. The battery may explode, causing personal injury or damage. Toxic fumes and materials are created when the battery is burned.

DO NOT CRUSH, DROP, OR DAMAGE THE CHARGER. Do not use a charger that has received a sharp blow, been dropped, run over, or damaged in any way.

BATTERY CHEMICALS CAUSE SERIOUS BURNS. Never allow the internal battery to come into contact with the skin, eyes, or mouth. If a damaged battery leaks chemicals, use rubber or neoprene gloves to dispose of it. If skin is exposed to battery fluids, wash with soap and water and rinse with vinegar. If eyes are exposed to battery chemicals, immediately flush with water for 20 minutes and seek medical attention. Remove and dispose of contaminated clothing.

DO NOT SHORT CIRCUIT. A battery will short circuit if a metal object makes a connection between the positive and negative contacts on the battery. A short-circuited battery may cause fire and personal injury.

DO NOT OPERATE UNDER BLANKET AND PILLOW. Excessive heating d cause fire, electric shock, or ir

STORING THE TEND AND CHARGER. Store in a cool, dry place.
Only charge the Tend when the ambient temperature is between
0°C/32°F and 40°C/104°F. Do not store the Tend where temperatures
may exceed 40°C/104°F such as in direct sunlight, in a vehicle, or metal building during the summer

DISPOSING OF BATTERIES. The Tend Lithium-ion batteries are more environmentally friendly than some other types of batteries. Always dispose of the Tend according to federal, state, and local regulations. Contact a recycling agency in your area for recycling locations.
