



## **BLEEDING SKULL RECIPE**



## WHAT YOU WILL NEED FOR 1 BLEEDING SKULL CANDLE

<a href="#">1x Skull - Pillar Candle Mould</a>
<a href="#">1x Clamshell - 4 Cavity Square</a>
<a href="#">135g Ecosystem RCX Melt Blend</a>
<a href="#">135g High Performance Melt (HPM) Blend</a>
<a href="#">27.5g Witches Brew Fragrance Oil</a>
<a href="#">0.18g Bekro Dye - 456 - Neon Green</a>
<a href="#">1x CL6 wick</a>
<a href="#">1x Minimum 9cm awl</a>

# CANDLE SHACK

## STEP 1

Place 135g of each wax into a double boiler. Once melted, mix the wax mixture well with a stirrer. The ideal temperature for the wax when completely melted is 60-65°C.

## STEP 2

Separate 45g of wax and add 0.18g of neon green dye. Mix it well until in solution. Add 5g of Witches Brew fragrance oil and mix it well. Pour the mixture to a clamshell.

## STEP 3

Add 22.5g of Witches Brew fragrance oil to the rest of your wax and mix it well.

## STEP 4

Pour approximately 35g of your solution to the skull mould and let it partly dry. Leave the rest of the mixture on heat to keep it liquid.

## STEP 5

Once bottom of the skull is still soft, place two green squares in place of a brain.

## STEP 6

Pour the rest of the mixture into the mould. Leave to dry completely for about 4 hours. Do not leave your candle to dry for too long. Otherwise, it will be difficult to wick the candle and it may crack.

## STEP 7

Demould your candle carefully.

## STEP 8

Heat your awl and slide it through your candle from the top of the head at the highest point, to the bottom, as straight as possible, creating a hole for the wick.

## STEP 9

Place the wick in your candle and trim it to 5mm. Allow your candle to cure for 48 hours for crystallisation.

## STEP 10

Light and enjoy your skull candle!
