






UNFOLDING THE STROLLER & INSTALLING STROLLER SEAT

- **To unfold the stroller:** Unhook the latch, located on the left side of the frame (Fig. 1).
- Pull the handlebar up and back until the stroller locks into place (Fig. 1A)
- To install stroller seat: Align in preferred orientation (Forward or reverse) and lower onto frame as shown (Fig. 1B).
- When installing/removing stroller seat, make sure white lines are aligned as shown (Fig. 1C).

ASSEMBLY





INSTALLING & REMOVING THE FRONT WHEELS

- To install front wheels: Push each front wheel into the front wheel bayonet until you hear a 'CLICK'. Ensure it is securely attached to the stroller before use. (Fig. 2)
- To remove the front wheels: Locate the release button which can be found at the back of the wheel bayonet (Fig 2A).
- While pushing the release button, gently remove the wheel from the bayonet (Fig. 2B).

INSTALLING & REMOVING THE REAR WHEELS

- To install rear wheels: Push each rear wheel into the rear wheel axle until you hear a 'CLICK'. Ensure it is securely attached to the stroller before use. (Fig. 3)
- **To remove the front wheels**: Locate the release button which can be found at the bottom of the axle (Fig. 3A).
- While pushing the button, gently remove the wheel from the axle (Fig. 3B).






- **To install child bar:** Align the child bar with the slot on the frame and slide in until you hear a 'CLICK'. Child bar is properly inserted when release buttons are in the raised position (Fig. 4).
- To remove child bar: Push in release buttons located at child bar connection slots and pull the child bar away from the stroller frame (Fig. 4A).

NOTE: Child bar can be inserted in either direction.

NOTE: Make sure child bar is secure before use by pulling on bar.



INSTALLING CANOPY





INSTALLING & REMOVING CANOPY

- **To install canopy:** Locate canopy sockets at sides of stroller seat, and button snaps/cord notches at back of stroller seat (Fig. 5, 5A)

 Arrange canopy with seat so button snaps are aligned with their connections at the **BACK** of stroller seat (Fig. 5B).

- Insert canopy connectors into canopy sockets. (Fig. 5C).
 Connect snaps at upper back of stroller seat (Fig. 5D).
 Wrap elastic band 2 (from canopy) around notches at lower back of
- **To remove canopy:** Undo both snaps at back of seat (Fig. 5D) Remove elastic bands from notches at the back of seat (Fig. 5E)
- Push in release buttons located on both sides of the canopy connectors and pull canopy away from stroller frame (Fig. 5F).

SECURING CHILD

Before Placing your Child in Stroller:

Close Canopy. Press both brake pedals down until they "click" into the locked position.


Make sure the brake pedals are pressed down completely.

Always set both brake pedals when parking the stroller.




Securing Child


- Place your child in the stroller. Position the crotch belt between your child's legs.
- Pull shoulder straps over child's arm and shoulder and fasten both strap ends to the restraint system.
- Fasten **both** waist belts to the buckle on each side of the crotch belt. Make sure you hear a "**click**" on both sides.
- Check to be sure the restraint system is securely attached by pulling it away from your child. The restraint system should remain attached.



• Tighten each waist belt and shoulder strap so that the restraint system is snug against your child.

Please refer to the next section for instructions to tighten the waist belts.





To tighten the waist belts and shoulder straps:


- Feed the anchored end of a waist belt up through the buckle to form a loop (A). Pull the free end of the waist belt (B).
- Repeat this procedure to tighten the other waist belt.
- Feed the top end of the shoulder strap through the plastic stay to form a loop **©**. Pull the bottom end down to tighten the strap **D**.
- Repeat this procedure to tighten the other shoulder strap.

To loosen the waist belts and shoulder straps:

- Feed the free end of the waist belt up through the buckle to form a loop (A). Enlarge the loop by pulling on the end of the loop toward the buckle. Pull the anchored end of the waist belt to shorten the free end of the waist belt (B).
- Repeat this procedure to loosen the other waist belt.
- Feed the bottom end of the shoulder strap through the plastic stay to form a loop **©**. Pull the top end up to loosen the strap **D**.
- Repeat this procedure to loosen the other shoulder strap.


Please note: After adjusting the restraint system to fit your child, make sure you pull on it to be sure it is securely fastened.










Fig. 1A Fig. 1B

- To engage the lock, Align the wheels forward and push the switch located at the rear of the front wheel down towards the wheel (Fig. 1)
- To release the lock, pull the switch up away from the wheel. (Fig. 1A)



USING THE REAR WHEEL BRAKES

- To engage brakes, apply a light downward pressure to the brake lever.
 Ensure that the brakes have been applied correctly and that the stroller will not move (Fig. 2).
- To release brakes, use foot to gently lift up the brake lever (Fig. 2A).



ADJUSTING FOOTREST ANGLE


- **To adjust footrest angle:** Press and hold both release buttons located at the leg rest joints (Fig. 3).
- While release buttons are held, adjust footrest angle to desired position and make sure buttons are in raised position before use. (Fig 3B)



ADJUSTING SEAT INCLINE & RECLINE


- **To adjust seat incline & recline:** Locate and squeeze the incline release trigger located at the upper back of the seat unit (Fig. 4)
- While holding trigger, angle up or down to adjust to one of two positions (Fig. 4A).


ADJUSTING HANDLEBAR HEIGHT

- **To adjust height:** Locate and squeeze the handlebar adjust trigger (Fig. 5)
- While holding trigger, adjust handlebar height and release until you hear a 'CLICK' at one of three height positions (Fig 5A).



REVERSING SEAT


- **To reverse seat:** Locate and squeeze the incline release trigger located at the upper back of the seat unit (Fig. 6)
- While squeezing trigger, angle the seat so it is vertical (Fig. 6A) and make sure white lines are aligned as shown (Fig. 6B)
- While squeezing trigger, pull seat away from frame (Fig. 6C)
- Replace seat in either **forward** or **rear** facing position (Fig. 6D)



EXTENDED CANOPY & MESH OPTIONS

- **To extend canopy:** Locate zipper on left edge of canopy and unzip (Fig. 7A).
- After unzipping, pull canopy forward to extend (Fig. 7B).
- **To reveal mesh:** After extending canopy, locate secondary zipper underneath the first, on left edge of canopy, and unzip (Fig. 7A).
- After unzipping, pull fabric over canopy to reveal mesh (Fig. 7C).
- To return to normal canopy: Follow these steps in reverse.

SETUP AND USE



FOLDING STROLLER IN FORWARD SEATED POSITION

- To fold in forward position: Fold leg rest up by lifting (Fig. 8).
- Locate the rotatable handle directly underneath the seat and, using your right hand, push up lock with your thumb while rotating clockwise in the direction of the arrow (Fig. 8A).
- Using your left hand, fold seat back until auto latch engages (Fig. 8B).

NOTE: Use your right hand during the fold, while using left hand to secure seat (Fig. 8B).

NOTE: If you have trouble engaging fold mechanism, use left hand to push stroller seat forward before attempting to fold back.

WARNING: Please make sure to secure seat with left hand throughout the duration of the fold.

FOLDING STROLLER IN REVERSE SEATED POSITION

- To fold in reverse position: Align seat angle with handlebar by pressing release trigger located at the upper back of the seat and angling as shown (Fig. 9)
- Locate the rotatable handle directly underneath the seat and, using your right hand, push up lock with your thumb while rotating clockwise in the direction of the arrow (Fig. 9A).
- Using your left, fold seat back until auto latch engages (Fig. 9B).


NOTE: It is suggested to use your right hand during the fold, while using left hand to secure seat.

NOTE: If you have trouble engaging fold mechanism, use left hand to push stroller seat up before attempting to fold back.

WARNING: Please make sure to secure seat with left hand throughout the duration of the fold.






REMOVE SEAT

- To remove seat: Locate and squeeze the incline release trigger located at the upper back of the seat unit (Fig. 2)
- While squeezing trigger, angle the seat so it is **vertical** (Fig. 2A) and make sure white lines are aligned as shown (Fig. 2B)
- While squeezing release trigger, pull seat away from frame (Fig. 2C)



INSTALL CLIPS

- **To install clips:** Locate connection points at joint where stroller seat was previously (Fig. 3)
- Align and insert clips in correct left and right sockets as shown until you hear a "CLICK" (Fig. 3A).



Press both buttons located on both sides of the carriage and lift upward on the adapter until fully removed from stroller. (Fig. 1E)
