WARNING: CHOKING HAZARD Adult assembly required because of small parts.

Keep (assembly parts) out of reach of children under 3 years.

CAUTION: Purses, shopping bags, parcels, diaper bags or accessory items may change the balance of the stroller and cause hazardous unstable conditions.

- The maximum weight that can be carried in the lower basket, and child tray, each is 3 lbs (1.36 kg). Excessive weight may cause a hazardous unstable condition to exist.
- Before allowing the children near the stroller, be certain the stroller is fully erect and latched in the open locked position.
- Use of the stroller with children weighing more than 45 pounds or over 42 inches tall, will cause
 excessive wear and stress on the stroller and may cause hazardous unstable condition to exist.
 NEVER use the stroller on stairways or escalators.
- NEVER use the stroller with roller skates or in-line skates.
 Never allow your stroller to be used as a toy.

To prevent injury:

Make sure all body parts are clear of the stroller when folding and unfolding.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- To clean the plastic parts on stroller use a mild cleaning solution with warm water on a sponge or damp cloth. Hand wash fabric with damp cloth and air dry. Do not use bleach.
- To keep your stroller wheels from squeaking, use silicone or graphite based lubricant.
- Check your stroller for loose screws, worn parts, torn material or stitching on a regular basis. Replace or repair parts as needed.
- Discontinue use of stroller if it should become damaged or malfunctions.








Canopy

Assembly

Remove stroller from box. The canopy, and child bar need to be installed prior to use.

WARNING: Care must be taken when folding and unfolding the stroller to prevent finger entrapment.




Opening Stroller

WARNING: Care must be taken when folding and unfolding the stroller to prevent finger entrapment.

- First, release the locking latch clip which is located on the left side of the stroller. (Fig. 1)
- Second, lift up on the stroller handle with both hands until the stroller frame is in a fully opened and locked position. (Fig. 1A) The stroller is in a fully locked position when stroller clicks. Prior to placing your child into the stroller, test to make sure stroller is in a fully opened and locked position.
- Make sure front wheels are facing the correct direction (Fig.1B).


Attaching Canopy To Attach Canopy:

- Locate the two metal tubing located on both sides of the front and back canopy. (Fig. 2).
- Insert the back canopy tubing into the inner piece housing located on the inner side of the stroller frame (Fig. 2A). Then wrap the elastic around the inner piece to fully secure (Fig. 2B). Repeat on opposite side of back canopy.
- Insert the front canopy tubing into the side of the stroller frame housing (Fig. 2C). Then wrap the elastic around the side of the stroller frame housing to fully secure (Fig. 2D). Repeat on opposite side of the front canopy.
- To securely fasten the canopy, velcro the back of the canopy to the back of the stroller seat (Fig. 2E).

Note: Pull outward on canopy to ensure that canopy is securely locked.

To Remove Canopy:

• First, remove all elastic bands located on both sides of the canopy. Then lift both metal tubing located on the front and back of the canopy upward until fully



Attaching / Removing Child Bar

To Attach Child Bar:


• Insert both sides of the child bar into the bottom part of the child bar (Fig. 3) until child bar "CLICKS" into a fully locked position.

Note: Pull upward on the child bar to ensure that the child bar is securely locked.


To Remove Child Bar:

 Press the tabs inward located on both sides of the child bar and lift upward until child bar is fully removed (Fig. 3A).


Push downward on brake lever to lock stroller




WARNING: Always lock brakes when the stroller is not being pushed so that the stroller will not roll away. Never leave stroller unattended on a hill or incline as the stroller may slide down the hill. WARNING: NEVER leave child unattended in stroller.

Rear Non-Swivel Wheel Brakes - One Touch Brake System

- To engage brakes: Apply light downward pressure to the linked brake lever located on the right side of the rear wheel axle. (Fig. 4) Check to make sure the brakes are in a fully locked position, making sure stroller will not move when pushed.
- To release brakes: Gently lift up on the linked brake lever (Fig. 4A).



Seat Back Adjustment


- Recline Position: Squeeze both sides on cord housing and pull away to recline seat, as shown in (Fig. 5A)
- **Upright Position:** Hold bottom cord loops while squeezing cord housing and move cord housing upwards the backseat, as shown in (Fig. 5B)


Canopy Adjustment

- To open canopy, push forward on the front frame of the canopy. Pull backwards on the canopy frame to fold completely (Fig. 6).
- To close the canopy, push on the front edge backward until canopy is all the way collapsed (Fig. 6A).



Foot Rest Adjustment

• **To adjust foot rest:** Pull lever located underneath footrest outward and rotate upward or downward to adjust to its desired position (Fig. 7). There are 2 footrest positions.



Peek-A-Boo

• Peek-A-Boo window is located on the top center of the canopy (Fig. 8).

SECURING CHILD

Before Placing your Child in Stroller:

Close Canopy. Press both brake pedals down until they "click" into the locked position.

Make sure the brake pedals are pressed down completely.

Always set both brake pedals when parking the stroller.




Securing Child


- Place your child in the stroller. Position the crotch belt between your child's legs.
- Pull shoulder straps over child's arm and shoulder and fasten both strap ends to the restraint system.
- Fasten **both** waist belts to the buckle on each side of the crotch belt. Make sure you hear a "**click**" on both sides.
- Check to be sure the restraint system is securely attached by pulling it away from your child. The restraint system should remain attached.



• Tighten each waist belt and shoulder strap so that the restraint system is snug against your child.

Please refer to the next section for instructions to tighten the waist belts.





To tighten the waist belts and shoulder straps:


- Feed the anchored end of a waist belt up through the buckle to form a loop (A). Pull the free end of the waist belt (B).
- Repeat this procedure to tighten the other waist belt.
- Feed the top end of the shoulder strap through the plastic stay to form a loop **©**. Pull the bottom end down to tighten the strap **D**.
- Repeat this procedure to tighten the other shoulder strap.


To loosen the waist belts and shoulder straps:


- Feed the free end of the waist belt up through the buckle to form a loop (A). Enlarge the loop by pulling on the end of the loop toward the buckle. Pull the anchored end of the waist belt to shorten the free end of the waist belt (B).
- Repeat this procedure to loosen the other waist belt.
- Feed the bottom end of the shoulder strap through the plastic stay to form a loop **©**. Pull the top end up to loosen the strap **D**.
- Repeat this procedure to loosen the other shoulder strap.


Please note: After adjusting the restraint system to fit your child, make sure you pull on it to be sure it is securely fastened.

Folding the Stroller

WARNING: Care must be taken when folding and unfolding the stroller to prevent finger entrapment.

NOTE: Make sure canopy is in it's fully closed position, seat is in a fully recline position before folding the stroller.

Folding the Stroller: Close the canopy as described on page 6 (Fig. 6A), position the seat to a recline position as described on page 5 (Fig. 5A). A dual action is needed to fold the stroller (Fig.19).

Action 1: Press the unlock tab with your thumb and hold. **1**

Action 2: While pressing unlock tab, press the fold lever inward and push stroller forward, then downward.

Once the stroller begins to fold, release the unlock tab and push downward until stroller is in a fully folded position (Fig.19A). Folding latch (located on the left side of the stroller) will automatically lock once stroller is in a fully folded and locked position. (Fig. 19B).
