Delta Children Strollers

Delta Children has added several new strollers to their already expansive line this year, and there's something for everyone: The [Revolve Reversible Stroller](#) (shown above; \$299.99) lets your child face in or out, features a one-handed fold in either position and sports real leather accents. It's a luxury, high-end stroller at an affordable price. The [Jeep Hydro Sport Plus Jogger](#) (\$249.99) is a versatile jogging stroller that smooths out bumpy roads for a smoother ride. The [Little Folks Classic Tour Plus Stroller](#) (\$129.99), a Walmart-exclusive brand, transforms from a bassinet to a reversible toddler stroller and has an adjustable-position reclining seat. The all-in-one [Jeep Gemini Stroller](#) (\$219.99) is lightweight (under 20 pounds) for travel and grows with your child. Best of all, it has an innovative middle fold that makes it easy to open and close. Also built for travel, the [Jeep Clutch Plus Travel Stroller with Reclining Seat](#) (\$199.99) is a TSA-approved carry-on stroller that weighs only 12.6 pounds, folds down compactly, and has an attached handle for carrying. It also reclines, which is rare in a travel stroller. If you're looking for a double stroller, consider the [Jeep Destination Side x Side Double Ultralight Stroller](#) (\$249.99). It's the best option for growing families. The seats recline independently, the front swivel-lock wheels lock for added stability on bumpy roads, and the slim frame fits through 30-inch doorways.
