# **FORYOURLITTLEONE TRIKE V3**

Insert the front wheel into the frame. See images, the metal spring clip should be pointing forward.

# STEP 2 & 3 Attach the front basket via the lungs shown..

Secure the handle bars by firmly pressing them down on the front wheel shaft until you hear an audible click..

#### STEP 5

Attach the brake mechanism by lining up the lungs then firmly push them onto the rear of the frame.

Time to attach the wheels, please note the order of these parts are crucial, it should be a long pin, followed by a rubber washer then a metal washer, then inserted through the wheel. Firmly push the wheel assembly through the brake mechanism and into the rear of the frame.

## **STEP 7 & 8**

Time for the handle bars, Insert the top handle into the Y section, time to link the steering assemblies. Make sure (image 6d) is inserted as shown in image. Insert the pole through the frame from underneath, making sure to push it all the way through. Support the bottom of the pole and push down on the parent handle until you hear an audible click (step 8 image).

## **STEP 9 & 10**

Lock the parents handle in place by lifting up the red lever. Now your trike should look like image 10.

# STEP 11,12,13 & 14

Link the steering assemblies by attaching the rod to the holes near the front wheel and the bottom of the parent handle (image 13). The hook end goes through the front tab, the threaded end goes through the rear tab.





#### **PLEASE NOTE**

If the parent handle doesn't perfectly line up with the front steering wheel, this rear threaded tab is adjustable allowing you to realign.

### **STEP 15 & 16**

Attach the rear basket by simply pushing it onto the rear of the frame and tighten down using the red knob.



# STEP 17, 18, 19 & 20

Place the seat cup onto the locating pin on the frame, the taller part goes to the rear.

Place the seat base onto the seat cup, again using the locating pin this time on the seat base.

Whilst supporting the seat thread the screw into the base of the seat, tighten to secure.

Simply attach the safety gate by depressing the retoggle and insert into the side of the seat. Lock the gate together by using the same process.



Step 21.

Time to attach the seat cover simply slide the seat over over the plastic seat mold and make sure the seat belts are through the holes provided on the seat mold. You will find the bottom of the seat cover will need to be added onto the safety gate you did in step 21.

#### STEP 23

Time to attach the hood, simply slide the hood onto the lungs located on the side of the seat.

#### STEP 24

The accessory pouch is simply attached via two press studs and velcro to secure the bottom.
