Recommended Yarn

SIZE

Width: approx. 46 cm.**Length:** approx. 185 cm.

MATERIAL

Schachenmayr wool4future, 50 g ball

Approx. 50 g ≈ 165 m

Fb 00002 (natural) 6 ball

Fb 00020 (pale yellow) 1 ball

Fb 00015 (caramel) 1 ball

Yarn amounts are approximate. Make sure to purchase enough of the same dye lot in order to complete your project.

Size 4 mm needles

Blunt yarn needle for weaving in ends.

TENSION

In main pattern:

21 sts and 32 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

Take time to check your gauge. If you have too many stitches and rows, switch to larger needles. If you have too few stitches and rows, switch to smaller needles.

THE BASICS

Main pattern:

Multiple of 4 + 2.

Row 1 [RS]: Knit all sts.**Row 2 [WS]:** ★ K2, p2; rep from ★, end k2.

Repeat rows 1 and 2 throughout.

STRIPE SEQUENCE

15 cm natural

10 cm caramel

10 cm pale yellow

115 cm natural

10 cm pale yellow

10 cm caramel

15 cm natural

INSTRUCTIONS

With natural cast on 98 sts and work in main pat following stripe sequence = 185 cm. Bind off all sts in pat on next WS row.

FINISHING

Pin scarf to measurements and block.

Carefully weave in all ends.

ABBREVIATIONS:

k = knit

p = purl

RS = right side

st (s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side
